Our Role at Bashaw School

Family and community wellness begins by reaching students and families in their educational setting within the Bashaw School. This is supported by our Family Wellness Worker, Lori Miller, in the capacity of emotional and social supports, programming and any other additional services required by bridging the Bashaw & Area Community Resource Centre's offerings as needed.

Through programming, one-on-one support or small group settings, students are able to grow and explore new opportunities. The Family Wellness Worker's role is to provide a safe place to listen and then holding that space for students and families no matter their concerns. Many topics are addressed including mental health, personal well-being, education, their joys, their challenges and their successes.

The Bashaw School is one of 6 key partners delivering a Model of Service for the community to help support individuals and families by providing confidential, integrated wrap around services. Their work links family and community support services, adult learning and literacy, justice, health, education and spirituality. Any door is the right door in this model as we navigate the systems with you!
