The Importance of Attendance

We have almost pulled through our cold/ flu season. It is important to be mindful of the handbook guidelines regarding absences. If your child is running a fever, they should not be at school. They must remain home for a full 24 hours after the fever breaks. This is for the health and safety of our entire school community. If your child is missing school, especially extended periods of time, it is imperative when they return to bring a doctor's note. This will excuse their absence and will ensure they do not reach an outstanding number of trancies. A student is chronically truant when as defined by the State of California as " EC Section 48263.6: Any pupil subject to compulsory full-time education or to compulsory continuation education who is absent from school without a valid excuse for ten percent or more of the school days in one school year ." These students are unable to master the material in the classroom and may be at risk of being unable to matriculate.
