1st Lt. George A. Johnson Co. A – 18th N. Carolina Infantry Grave Marker #1048
W in back Hanover C.H. 5/27 POW in U.S. Hosp. System D/6-9-1862, B 6-9

Corporal Gabriel R. Lilly Co. H – 18th North Carolina Infantry #1489
W in left side at Hanover C.H., POW died enroute Yorktown 5-27-1862, B 5-27

Private Gerhard D. Hackeman Co. A - 18th North Carolina Infantry #1361
W in right leg at Hanover C.H. 5/27, POW died in Yorktown Hosp. 6-1-1862, B 6-1

Private John Sibbet Co. H - 18th North Carolina Infantry #1233
W in left ankle/leg at Hanover C.H. 5/27. POW died in Yorktown Hosp. 6-11-1862, B 6-11

Private William H. McNeil Co. F - 18th North Carolina Infantry #1057
W in foot at Hanover C.H. 5/27, POW, D in Yorktown 6/8, B 6-14-1862

Private George F. Debose Co. E - 18th North Carolina Infantry #1359
W in thigh at Hanover C.H. 5/27, POW, died in hospital system, B 6-15-1862

Private Wallace W. Long Co. C - 18th North Carolina Infantry #1080
W in right thigh at Hanover C.H. 5-27-1862, POW, died in hospital system, B 6-24-1862

Private Everett J. Brett Co. ___ - ___ North Carolina Infantry #1212
B 5-27-1862

Private B. T. Register Co. C - 7th North Carolina Infantry #1198
W in back at Hanover C.H. 5/27, POW, D in hospital system. B 5-30-1862

Private William W. Gordon Co. C - 13th North Carolina Infantry #1570
Left sick in Yorktown Hosp. on 5/3. Died in Union Hospital in late May, 1862.

Private Andrew Gentry Co. A - 37th North Carolina Infantry #1081
W in mouth at Hanover C.H. 5/27, POW, D on wounds 5/27, buried in Yorktown.

All members of the 18th, 7th and 37th N. Carolina were in Branch's Brigade at Hanover C. H. The wounded POWs were evacuated by water to Yorktown and either died enroute or died in the Yorktown hospitals. The 13th N. Carolina was in Colston's Brigade in the Yorktown defenses & Private Gordon was left behind in the withdrawal. Private Brett cannot be found, probably a spelling problem, but it appears likely he was also in Branch's Brigade.
