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AVON WINTERFEST – OVERVIEW

Overview

Bottoms Up is looking for ways to provide further opportunities for community-based events within Avon and the Farmington Valley area including, but not limited to; Avon, Canton, Simsbury, Farmington, and Unionville. A committee has been formed consisting of local business owners, community members, and the Avon/Canton Chamber of Commerce.

LOGISTICS/SIZE

Winterfest will take place on the Avon Village Green, as well as crossing over Ensign Dr at crosswalk onto Waterslide Rd and going towards the new Avon Village Center shopping area. The majority of activities will take place within the Avon Village Green parking area and near the gazebo. Ideally, this inaugural event will become an annual tradition within the community and surrounding towns for years to come. We are working with the Carpionato Group Director of Marketing and Design, Krystal Carcieri Carnes for logistics on this event and have gained approval from the property owners as well as businesses within the Avon Village Green. The size of the event will be determined by capacity limits at venue as well as current COVID-19 State guidelines. We estimate 500-1,000 attendees per day/night. The event will last 3 days.

DATE/TIME

The event will take place during the weekend from December 3rd - 5th, 2021. Time for the event will be 6:00 pm - 10:00 pm EST on Friday, 4:00pm - 10:00pm EST on Saturday, and from 9:00am - 3:00pm EST on Sunday.

AUDIENCE

Winterfest will be an all-inclusive, fun, and winter-themed, family friendly event. We will have activities for all ages.

TRAFFIC CONTROL

We will coordinate traffic control with the Town of Avon, Police Department, Fire Department and working with the Connecticut Department of Transportation as needed.

PARKING FOR PATRONS

We will work with the Town of Avon and the Carpionato Group and surrounding businesses with larger lots to determine best approach for parking and getting people to the venue. We will have designated vendor parking and shuttle service available. Our initial proposal is to utilize a portion of the Marriott Parking Lot (approved by owners-Carpionato Group). We will also reach out to the Town for additional parking options (Board of Education and adjacent park, HealthTrax parking lot and shuttle service). We will work to setup appropriate checkpoints upon entry to the event for temperature monitoring for any participants should State COVID-19 guidelines require.

SECURITY

We will work with the Police department and engage private security as deemed appropriate to ensure a safe and secure environment for this event. Tents will be monitored by security 24 hours for entire event.

INSURANCE

We will work with the Carpionato Group to provide COI for event. Details to follow.

Overview

Bottoms Up and Dom's Coffee/Cheese Shop will sponsor the event. We will work with local businesses to put together an Avon Winterfest program to include Map of Event, Activities Agenda, Highlight Featured Vendors, and more.

Winterfest will be a throwback to the European-style Christkindl market. We will "recreate" the magic of this special market with a German themed holiday event. 

VENDOR AREA OVERVIEW

This is a rough outline at this time until location, vendor selection, and all permits and approvals are finalized with the Town of Avon, Department of Transportation, and State.

VENDOR AREA DETAILS

Primary Lot (Avon Village Green)

There will be one large area (#3 in map) in the parking lot adjacent to Pasta Vita. This will be reserved for food trucks. The front parking closest to Past Vita will remain open for businesses to conduct normal hours throughout the weekend. The second, smaller lot (#2b and #3b on map) will have lighted bar height tables and serve as food courts. These areas will have heating stations for visitors.

A large, heated tent will be placed to the left of #2b on the map. The tent size will measure 40x110). This will have two entrance/exit points. The generator(s) will be across from this large tent as indicated on the map.

There will also be 5 individual tents near the small parking space by the right Ensign Dr. entrance. The side parking lot that is facing Ensign Dr. will accommodate another 30 individual tents.

Secondary Lot (Waterside Dr.) - there will be 5 Individual Tents set up in the parking spaces on the left as you enter from Ensign Dr. Each individual tent will measure 10x10 (#7 locations in the map).

Tent, Generators, Tables

Tents Unlimited will supply all tents and generators for this event. They will setup on Thursday, December 2nd and are prepared to come back as needed in the event of more than 6 inches of snow to clean off roofs and ensure integrity of each tent during the event. The will breakdown the event on Monday, December 6th through Wednesday, December 8th.

BreMar Rental will supply 15 lighted tables (5-red, 5-blue, 5-green) for the food court areas. They will also supply the heaters for the heating stations and propane tanks.

Vendor Tent Options

Vendors may select from either one of the following options:

- Primary Big Tent -1 8ft table Heated Tent, doors to keep items stored/security monitoring
- Primary Big Tent 2 8ft tables Heated Tent, doors to keep items stored/security monitoring
- Primary Lot Individual Tent
- Secondary Lot Individual Tent

Vendor Application Process

Overview

There will be a limited number of vendors for Winterfest in its initial event. Vendors will complete an online Vendor Application Process (see form on page 10). There will be a submission deadline of October 15th. A special committee will review all submissions and contact vendors that are chosen. This phased process will ensure a wide variety of products being offered at the event.

Phase	Description	Important Dates
Phase 1	Applicants apply online and register their interest in becoming a vendor.	August 1 st - October 15 th
Phase 2	Vendor Review Committee selects qualified applicants.	October 18 th - October 22 nd
Phase 3	Applicants are selected and contacted. Terms & Conditions must be reviewed and signed.	October 25 th - October 29 th
Phase 4	Vendors must pay within 30 days and receive confirmation, table/tent location, and final vendor information.	November 1 st - November 15 th
Phase 5	Vendors are announced and displayed on the official Avon Winterfest Website.	December 1 st - December 31 st

Vendors will be selected based on the type of products that best compliment our winter-themed event such as; glass-blown ornaments, fresh wreaths and greens, Bavarian-inspired sweets, German-inspired embroidered linens, holiday nutcrackers, beer steins, traditional German-inspired food and beverage such as bratwurst, sauerkraut, Stollen, Gluhwein, alcoholic/non-alcoholic drinks reminiscent of gingerbread, sugar cookies, peppermint and many more product offerings keeping our theme in mind.

- 1. <u>Utilize the Round Up Program</u> as a vendor at checkout details on how to complete this process will be sent once you are an approved vendor in our terms and conditions.
- 2. <u>10% of each day/night net proceeds</u> from event will be allocated to Bottoms Up. Proof of register/receipts required.
- 3. <u>Vendor Donated Raffle Item</u> to be displayed during event at your tent or table Minimum \$50
