- 1. **Volunteer Coordinator** responsible for ensuring staffing for major activities, ground maintenance, and other important areas to ensure safety and security of patrons.
- 2. **Decorations Lead** this role will focus on the green and gazebo area to create winterthemed scape using existing decorations and coordinating with this year's event theme
- 3. **Vendor Lead** responsible for reach out to local businesses or other vendors with special focus on holiday specialty items such as glass-blown ornaments, nutcrackers, nestling dolls, wood carved items, and other seasonal products to fill vendor tent.
- 4. **Food/Beverage Lead** responsible for coordination and communication between food trucks, beverage servers/vendors, and working with Farmington Valley Health District.
- 5. **Entertainment Coordinator** Work with event director to cast entertainment, fulfill stage/audio equipment needs, create schedule of activities, etc.
- 6. **Publicity Lead** this role will focus on marketing and advertising components including, but not limited to; disbursement of yard signs, creation of banners, all signage for fundraising efforts and sponsorship acknowledgements, entrances, donation kiosks, newspaper, tv, and other media outlets.
- 7. **Site Coordinator** This role will help with coordination of site necessities such as tenting, rentals, electrical needs, generator needs, police, fire, ambulance, and more.
- 8. Activities Coordinator responsibilities in this position will include creating activities for children ages 12-18. These will include ice skating rink, inflatables/carnival games, carnival rides, other to be determined.
