

PICKSTOWN PLANNING & ZONING  
COMMISSION MEETING  
RAINBOW ROOM, PICKSTOWN, SD  
JANUARY 7, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 6:25 P.M. Present were Lee Strivens, Richard Crabtree, Gary Wiesner and Ron Mabie. Absent was Sandy Daggett.

The agenda for this meeting was read. A motion was made by Crabtree and seconded by Strivens to approve the agenda. All voted aye, motion carried.

The minutes from the August 20, 2018 meeting were read. A motion was made by Strivens and seconded by Crabtree to approve the minutes. All voted aye, motion carried.

Our mission was discussed. Crabtree said he wanted to explain what we do here and add an addendum to the Comprehensive Plan. After discussion Mabie made a motion to have Crabtree put together a draft mission statement that can be reviewed and forwarded to the Board of Trustees, which was seconded by Strivens. All voted aye, motion carried.

Discussed whether a meeting should be set up to start the process of reviewing and updating the Comprehensive Plan which expires this year. It was decided to do this at the next meeting and also to continue monthly meetings. Meetings will be held on the first Monday of the month at 6:30 P.M. in the Rainbow Room.

Gary Wiesner was welcomed to the Commission. He was recently appointed by the Board of Trustees to replace Pam Castle whose term expired December 11, 2018.

It was pointed out that Gary & Jill Wiesner didn't need to have a variance to build a boatshed over the property line on Lot 14 of Block 9 and Outlot 7, per the City Attorney, as they own both lots.

A motion was made by Mabie and seconded by Wiesner that the meeting be adjourned. All voted aye, motion carried.

The next meeting was scheduled for February 4, 2019 at 6:30 P.M. The Public Hearing for the rezoning of two lots on Abdnor Drive, that was scheduled for December 27, 2018 and cancelled due to a winter storm, will be held at this time.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 P.M.
