Volunteer Spotlight



Goldens 901 depends greatly on the genuine care, compassion, and hard work of Julia Heevner. In addition to the regular responsibilities she has chosen, she consistently volunteers for special projects and events! Read below as she tells us how she got started and what she does.

"I fostered for Love A Golden in St. Louis and then with MAGRR starting in 2007. When I originally got involved in Golden Retriever rescue it was because I really wanted to help with stray and abandoned dogs and Golden Retrievers were the type of dog that I already had. It helped me be able to focus and not be overwhelmed by the huge problem that it is. For Goldens 901, I am the Adoption Coordinator. This involves answering applications as they come in, checking their vet records and then passing them to our home visit coordinator. I also do home visits some of the time. When a new Golden comes into the rescue, our team discusses which home would be the best fit for the dog.

Our main concern is always getting the dog the best home for him or her. If there are any concerns we take them to the committee. Of course, the entire organization has great teamwork so I also help out with checking the P.O. box , setting up events and I foster occasionally. It is a great honor and very rewarding to be working with this group of people."

Heartworm Awareness Matters!



February is not just about celebrating love; it's also Heart Month, a time to raise awareness about heart health! For dogs, heartworm disease is serious potentially life-threatening.



Heartworm disease is 100% preventable with regular medication, year round treatment. There are various options, including monthly oral tablets, topical treatments, and even an annual injection.



If your dog is diagnosed with heartworms, treatment involves a series of injections to kill the worms, followed by strict rest periods. After treatment, dogs need regular follow-ups to monitor their recovery.



Talk to your vet about the best prevention plan for your pet, and make heartworm protection a priority year-round!

Courtney helped start Goldens 901, originally serving as the vet and medical coordinator. As part of the intake process, she often went to The Pet Hospitals to meet incoming dogs, making sure surrendered dogs were thoroughly checked.

Courtney leaves behind a legacy of unconditional love for the countless dogs whose lives were made better by her care and companionship. Her spirit will live on in the paw prints left on our hearts and in the lives of every Golden friend she touched.
