
PETITE GENERATION

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What Is Petite Generation?

Petite Generation consists of two groups of dancers. One is ages 8-10 and the other is ages 6-8. These dancers are invited by their teachers. The parent(s) will receive an emailed invitation for their dancer to participate. They perform at community performances, one competition and both recitals.

How many classes are they required to take?

Petites take a minimum of two classes a week. One Ballet class and their Generation class.

When will they have classes?

6-8 yr olds have classes on Wednesday afternoons and 8-10 yr olds have classes on Saturday mornings.

What is the Generation Class?

During the Generation class, dancers will work on choreography for a ballet dance and a jazz dance. These will be performed during the year.

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
