D23 Interleague Rules.

- 1. Bat rules: No USSSA bat rules permitted. USA logo on bats. BBCore used at only intermediate, junior and senior levels. LL Rule.
- 2. Follow pitch count rules. They are on the manager pitch count form, including required days rest. Keep in mind, if a 10 year old is playing in the majors, the pitch count max is 75, not 85 like the 11 and 12's! LL Rule
- 3. Use of game changer is highly recommended.
- 4. All managers will use the new pitch count form. It must be carried to all games and shared before and after every game. A player reaching the threshold or max pitches may finish his batter and his pitch threshold reverts back to his first pitch of the at bat.
- 5. There are no balks in the minors and majors. For intermediate and higher, the first balk per pitcher will be a warning. Please share this with the umpire prior to each game.
- 6. 5 run rule applies at all levels except senior. Unlimitted runs in last inning.
- 7. Minors may steal home. This is a LL rule.
- 8. Call opposing manager a few days before each game to confirm, date, time and field!
- 9. There is no on deck circle for minors and majors...this is a LL rule which is often violated.
- 10. 2 hour game time limit across the levels. (except senior).
