

Any person(s) who is mounted at any time on property at Hitch Stables or Serenity Farms must wear protected head gear in accordance with current USEF Guidelines.

Important Information:

- First through Eight place ribbons awarded in each class.
- Division Championship presented for each division that is considered filled with 3 or more competitors.
- Starred Jumper Classes will be Bonus Points Class for Championship calculations.
- A minimum of 12 entries are required in all prize money classes for prize money to be paid out. Once a prize money class has started, no scratches will be allowed. Adds should be made in horse show office with an add slip.
- Stalls are **NON-REFUNDABLE** after October 12, 2025.
- Horse must show in at least one over fence class to be eligible for the hunter under saddle
 of the division; exceptions Open Hunter, Open Equitation and Covered Ring divisions.
- Training and Warm-up Classes will be allowed to be entered multiple times. Management reserves the right to limit the multiple entry if time schedule dictates.

<u>Beginner Equitation Trot X-Rails</u> – Beginner riders who have not jumped over fences 2' or higher at any show. Riders may only cross enter Advanced Beginner Trot X Rails. LHJA

Adult Hunter – 3' Open to adult amateur riders. Horse/Rider combination may not show in Amateur Owner Hunter at the same show. LHJA, MHJA

<u>Children's/MHJA Pony</u> – Small/Medium 2', Large 2'6". Ponies jump according to measured height. USEF age rules apply for pony riders regarding size. LHJA, MHJA

<u>Junior/Amateur Owner Hunter</u> - 3'3" Open to Junior and amateur riders. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter Children's or Adult Hunters.

Modified Child/Adult Hunter – 2'9" Open to junior and amateur riders. Rider may not cross enter classes 3'3" or higher at this show. LHJA, MHJA

<u>Limit Rider Hunter</u> - 2'6" Open to Riders who have not won 6 first placings over fences at 2'6" or higher. LHJA

<u>X-Rail "Jumper" Equitation</u> – Open to riders in Beginner, Adv. Beginner X-Rails, Mini Stirrup, and Pre-Short/Long Stirrup. To be shown over a jumper style course, judged on equitation. Excessive speed will be penalized.

<u>High Schooling Jumper</u> – 1.05m (3'3"-3'5") Open to all horses and riders. May be combined with 1.15m Jumpers if fewer than 3 entries in either section. LHJA, MHJA

1.15m Jumper – (3'7"-3'9") Open to all horses and riders. May be combined with High Schooling Jumpers if fewer than 3 entries in either section. LHJA

Classics, Derby and Special Class Specifications

General Derby & Classic Rules:

- A minimum of twelve (12) entries must be entered in any class with prize money for full prize money amount to be paid out. Management will evaluate a lesser entry fee and total prize money on a case by case basis.
- All derbies must have a minimum of twelve (12) entries by Saturday at 4:00PM or they could be combined.
- Equitation and Hunter Classics will have the second round of the division scored for first round of classic. Second round of classic will run concurrently ("For those of you who went to LSU, that means at the same time." Mike McReynolds) with the division. Classics may only be done once by the rider for equitation and once per horse for hunters.
- Jumpers may show in a maximum of TWO (2) Jumper Classics.
- Derby entries must be shown in at least two over fence classes at this show.
- No ADDS or SCRATCHES from the derby once it has started. Entries added after the order is posted will go in the order at Management or Ring Starter's discretion.
- ALL Derby Judging & Format: A two-round format (management reserves the right to change format to a hunt and go) utilizing an open numerical score in the Classic Hunter Round (first round) on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality, substance, and movement. In addition, the base score in the Handy Hunter Round (second round) reflects brilliance of pace and handiness. In each round, after the judge's base score is given, one point will be added for each high option fence jumped up to a maximum of four. The point will be added even if there is a refusal, rail down, or loss of good jumping style at that fence providing that the horse and rider combination does jump the higher height fence option. The Handy Hunter Round will incorporate options such as tight turns, clever options for jump approaches, hand galloping, trotting a fence, or walking through an obstacle. The 12 highest scoring entries are eligible to return for the second round.
- Horse/Rider combination may only do ONE derby.

154. \$1,000 Mike McReynolds 3' Hunter Derby: Entry Fee \$100 Open to all horses and riders. The posted order of go will be a blind draw available the night before. Option fences set at 3'5". See Prize Money Distribution Table

155. Lead Line: No entry fee. The Future Riders of Tomorrow to be led around the arena and follow simple directions and/or answer questions from the judge. Costumes or Show Clothes are allowed.

Riders are not eligible if they show over 2'11" at this show. Option fences set at 2'9" See Prize Money Distribution Table



74. Costume Team Relay: Entry Fee \$30 Competition for a team of two. A horse may only compete once, but riders are allowed to compete on more than one horse. The course is Table II.2d, divided into Power and Speed phases with faults accumulating for both phases. Riders will swap between the power phase and speed phase. Riders may remount how ever they choose but keep in mind the fastest time wins! COSTUMES for Horse and Rider are encouraged. If you are costuming the horse, please keep safety in mind for both horse and riders.


