

**Results of CUSA Referendum, 2021**

FundQi is a grant program currently in use by the Carleton University Student Association hereby referred to as CUSA. A successful referendum will make FundQi no longer an ancillary fee and students will no longer have access to the Carleton-specific pricing for the service. The cost is \$100 per year for a premium FundQi membership. Current students access FundQi premium for \$9.99 (subject only to be increased to adjust for inflation) per academic term for a total of \$20 per year but may opt out through the FundQi website should they choose to do so and should they be willing to give FundQi personal information for the reimbursement.

Abstentions include both those who selected no candidate as well as those who selected the distinct 'Abstain' option on the ballot.

The referendum achieved enough votes to be considered a valid referendum result.

To the best of my abilities, these results accurately count all votes cast in the 2021 CUSA Referendum. There has been no evidence of vote manipulation or any other disruption to the electronic voting system.
