Translocation Experiment Support Tasks for Mohave Ground Squirrel RFP MGSWCB 26-1

MGSCC Grant Coordinator:

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Questions are below in black with answers in **blue**.

1. How many times per week will the contractor be tracking the 20 animals?
Animals will be tracked seven (7) days per week, with the goal of obtaining fixes on each animal at least three (3) times each day.
2. How many cameras will the contractor install?
The contractor will work with MGSCC (Field Manager and possibly volunteers) to install between 100 and 200 cameras. For purposes of costing, assume the contractor will install 200 cameras.
3. Will the contractor be providing the telemetry equipment?
Yes – equipment will be available at the storage unit in Ridgecrest, CA and contractor will be given access. It will be expected that all equipment used will be returned in the same working condition and the Field Manager and Grant Coordinators notified within 24 hours of any equipment loss or malfunction.
4. Will the contractor be providing the cages and shade and if so, how many cages are anticipated?
MGSCC will provide all materials for cages, and the contractor will work with the MGSCC Field Manager to prepare and construct cages. Assume field hours as stated in the RFP.
5. Will the Contractor be providing the artificial burrows and if so, how many?
MGSCC will provide all materials for artificial burrows, and the contractor will work with the MGSCC Field Manager to prepare and construct artificial burrows. Assume field hours as stated in the RFP.
