

Trapping Effort Information:

- **Dates:** approximately between May 18-May 29
 - May 18: Mandatory training, half day – remainder will be grid setup
 - May 19-20: grid setup and/or pre-baiting
 - May 21-28 (or 29th): Active trapping (maybe shift one day or so),
- **Main PIs:** Bruce Garlinger and Denise LaBertaux for Coso grid and others
- **Coso Grids:** 225 traps, .5 mile hike into trapping grid, other support for volunteer trapping may also be needed
- **Locations:** Attached
- **Assistance needed:**
 - Trap setup and takedown
 - Pre-baiting
 - Data collection
 - Note: will see MGS, but handling is not guaranteed

Requirements for volunteering:

- Minimum of 3-day commitment
- **MUST** attend May 18th in-person training
- Previous small mammal experience preferred
