The Maryland State House Holiday Tree & Wreath Project features designs by Federated Garden Clubs of Maryland from 23 Counties and Baltimore City. In 2015, Maryland's First Lady, Yumi Hogan, initiated the project, which continued through 2022 except during the Covid pandemic (2020 and 2021). Maryland's current First Lady, Dawn Moore, has continued this wonderful Annapolis holiday tradition during Governor Wes Moore's term in office. Each December, with great joy and enthusiasm, Federated Garden Club members arrive from all over Maryland to transform the State House Rotunda into a holiday delight.

The Somerset County Garden Club celebrates the diversity of our native plant material with this holiday display.

The tree silhouette is constructed of branches from the bald cypress (*Taxodium distichum*) and from the loblolly pine (*Pinus taeda*).

The tree is adorned with foliage from

- American beautyberry (*Callicarpa americana*),
- American holly (ilex opaca),
- bee balm (*Monarda fistulosa*),
- eastern red cedar (*Juniperus virginiana*),
- highbush blueberry (*Vaccinium corymbosum*),
- inkberry holly (*Ilex glabra*),
- red switchgrass (*Panicum virgatum*),
- spicebush (*Lindera benzoin*),
- white pine (*Pinus strobus*) and
- pinecones from the loblolly tree.

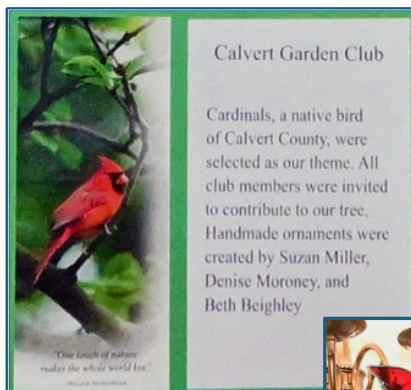

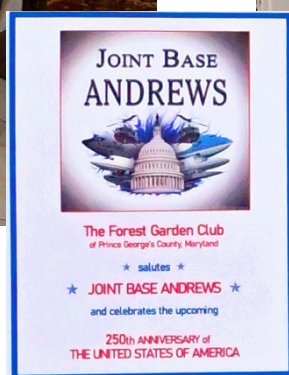

In 1834, three railroad lines converged in Washington County: the Western Maryland, the Baltimore and Ohio, and the Chesapeake and Ohio (C&O). Hagerstown's nickname became the "Hub City," due to the three railroad lines' representing the spokes of a wagon wheel on the map.
