Questions to Consider Chapter 3

- 1. Having shown that Jesus is greater than any angel, our author now sets out to show that Jesus is greater than Moses. Why did our author select Moses for comparison?
- 2. What is the Church? What is the House of God? When we welcome people to the House of God, what are we doing?
- 3. What does this mean, "For if we are faithful to the end, trusting God just as firmly as when we first believed, we will share in all that belongs to Christ."

Chapter 4

- 4. Beginning in Ch. 2, and in Ch. 3, Jesus is called our High Priest. In Ch. 4 Jesus is called our "great High Priest." There were many Jewish priests. What is significant about a High Priest?
- 5. Rest is mentioned a number of times in this chapter. What do you think it meant to the people hearing or reading this sermon two thousand years ago? What does it mean to you?
- 6. There are a number of verses in this Book that have become greatly appreciated and loved over the centuries. Here is one, "For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires."
