**Questions to Consider**  
**Chapter 5**

1. In this chapter, having now been acknowledged as our “Great High Priest,” Jesus is further distinguished as “a High Priest in the order of Melchizedek.” Who is this Melchizedek, and why is this important?
2. Jesus, as High Priest, “is able to deal gently with ignorant and wayward people because he himself is subject to the same weaknesses.” How do you deal with such people?
3. In verses 11-14 (and 6:1-3), the believers are called to spiritual growth...to grow beyond having to be taught the basics over and over. What does spiritual maturing mean to you? How does one become more mature?

4. Verses 4-6 pose an important question, “Is it possible to start on the road to salvation, then lose faith and in the process lose salvation?” What is your assessment?
5. The entirety of Chapter 6 is an argument for not abandoning faith in Jesus. How would you make this argument to church members today?
