**34th Avenue Residents
From 69th Street to Junction Boulevard
and everyone affected by Open Streets Program**

Department of Transportation projects affecting our neighborhood

The following are changes being made to 34th Avenue, our streets and bus routes:

- The DOT has begun tearing up the avenue from 77th Street to 80th Street as they will begin work in what they call “Paseo Park”. They have eliminated over 100 parking spaces on 78th Street between 34th and 35th Avenue in order to make the street a two-way street and NO parking is allowed. Access being denied to seniors and the disabled. This is just the beginning as the DOT takes over 26 city blocks on 34th Avenue.
- The DOT has eliminated 23 stops on the Q66 bus route in key locations which directly affects our seniors and the disabled, students from IS145 and patients who no longer have a stop in front of the medical facility on 73rd Street. Seniors and the disabled now have to walk extra 2-3 blocks to be able to catch the Q66.
- The DOT plans to “redesign” Northern Boulevard by allowing one lane for Outdoor Dining Shacks, one lane for buses and one lane for vehicles. With the closure of 26 blocks on 34th Avenue 7 days a week/13 hour a day, Northern Boulevard has become a traffic nightmare which has increased noise and air pollution.
