Ending (Resolution):

- Show how the character overcomes the challenge.
- What did they learn? How have they changed?
- Leave a lasting impact—an emotional or thought-provoking ending.

3. Tips for a Strong Creative Writing Essay:

Use Vivid Descriptions:

Instead of "It was dark," write:

"The moon hid behind thick clouds, and shadows swallowed the path ahead."

✓ Show, Don't Tell:

Instead of "She was scared," write:

"Her hands trembled, and her breath came in short, shallow gasps as she stepped forward."

Create a Unique Protagonist:

Give your character personality, dreams, and flaws. What makes them different?

✓ Build Suspense:

Make the reader wonder: Will they succeed? How will they find their strength?

End with a Powerful Message:

Leave the reader with something to think about—how challenges shape us, or how strength is found in unexpected places.
