Setting Description (20 points): Use descriptive language to bring each of the four scenes to life. Appeal to the senses and create an atmosphere that enhances the mystery and adventure.

Originality and Creativity (15 points): Demonstrate original thought and creativity in the plot and character decisions. Avoid clichés and predictable scenarios.

Grammar and Mechanics (15 points): Use proper grammar, punctuation, and spelling. Writing should be clear and understandable.

Total possible points: 100

Argument Development (30 points): Present logical arguments supported by evidence from credible sources, statistics, and real-world examples that illustrate the extent and impact of discrimination and equity issues.

Solution Proposals (25 points): Provide well-thought-out solutions that address the challenges discussed. These should be practical, achievable, and innovative, showing an understanding of the societal and policy implications.

Persuasive Techniques (15 points): Effectively use persuasive language, emotional appeal, and ethical reasoning to convince the reader of your position.

Conclusion (10 points): Summarize your main points and restate your thesis, emphasizing the importance of the issue and the impact of the proposed solutions.

Writing Mechanics (5 points): Demonstrate command of language with clarity, proper grammar, and punctuation.

Total possible points: 100
