Join fellow British car drivers and BMCSNJ members for a fall tour through the Eastern Jersey pinelands beginning in Somers Point NJ to our final destination in Smithville Village.

After leaving Somers Point at 10:00 am, first stop will be Atlantic County Park at Lake Lenape. This is a great place to stretch. There are open facilities and a nice view across the lake.

This is also the alternate meeting site for drivers who may live on the western side of South Jersey. Those who choose to join us there please arrive at 10:30 am. The tour will be leaving the park no later than 11:00 am.

We'll have a second short break at Batsto Village and then continue to our final destination, Smithville Village where you'll be on your own to visit their shops and food offerings.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

NOTE: A WAWA is on MacArthur Blvd Rt.52 not far from the park so it might be a good idea to stop there first in case you need gas or to use the bathrooms. Masks are required in WAWA.

 Meet at John F. Kennedy Park in Somers Pt. Entrance at 54 Broadway, Somers Point, NJ GPS: 39.307246, -74.606027. Parking is around the park area.
 SET ODOMETER TO ZERO

(TOTAL Miles)

- 2. At 0 miles Exit JFK Park and turn right on Broadway.
- 3. At 0.3 mi Turn left on Mays Landing Rd. Rt 559
- 4. At 6.6 mi Turn left on Rt. 559 N.
- 5. At 13.7 mi At light bear left onto 617 W.
- 6. At 13.9 mi Next light turn left to continue on 617 W.
- 7. At 14.2 mi Turn left at light onto 40 W/Harding Hwy.
- 8. At 14.6 mi Turn right at light past McDonalds onto 559 N Detour/Mill St/616 N
 - 9. At 15.4 mi Turn left onto 559 N. (before closed bridge)
 - 10. At 15.6 mi Turn right into Lake Lenape Atlantic County Park, 1st bathroom stop
 park in first lot. Bathrooms located in boat house.
 - **Alternate meeting point for some members.

Lake Lenape parking lot. Entrance across street from 6150 Atlantic 559, Mays Landing, NJ. GPS: 39.456153, -74.739969

Leaving park no later than 11:00 am RESET ODOMETER TO ZERO

(TOTAL Miles)

- 11. At 0 mi Exit park, turn right
- 12. At 0.3 mi Turn right on Weymouth Rd. 559 N.
- 13. At 5 mi At intersection of 322, stay in center lane and cross over, continuing on 559 N.
- 14. At 5.9 mi Bear to the right onto 623 N. Look out for bumpy RR Crossing
- 15. At 10.8 mi -Cross intersection of Rt. 30, stay on 623 N. Proceed through traffic and flashing light
- 16. At 15.7 mi Turn left at "T" 623 N. towards Batsto
- 17. At 16.4 mi Turn right onto 542 E
- 18. At 17.2 mi Turn left into Batsto Village (look for flagpoles)

 Take first left into parking area. No charge for
 admission, bathroom break.

DO NOT RESET ODOMETER - Total miles include entrance and exit

- 19. At 18.2 mi Exit Batsto and turn left onto 542E
- 20. At 23.6 mi At about mile 5 look for "end of measured mile" sign on the right and a long white fence on left and then turn right on Old Church Rd.
- 21. At 24.6 mi Turn right at "T" onto Old River Rd. Drive slowly through Lower Bank.
- 22. At 25.4 mi -At stop sign turn right onto 652 W and go across drawbridge. (road a little bumpy)


(TOTAL Miles)

- 23. At 28 mi Turn left onto 563
- 24. At 28.2 mi Quick left turn onto 624 E towards Port Republic
- 25. At 34.8 mi Drive under overpass for GSP then take 45 degree right turn onto 650
- 26. At 34.9 mi Proceed through two stop-signs, cross the causeway then turn left on 610 at "T".
- 27. At 36.4 mi Proceed through 1st stop sign, then at 2nd stop sign turn right onto 610
- 28. At 37.4 mi Turn right on Rt. 9 at Smithville LOOK LEFT FOR TRAFFIC!
- 29. At 37.5 Turn right on 561 N./ Moss Mill Rd.
- 30. Enter Village Green parking lot on right past the Grist Mill. **You have arrived!!**

Smithville Parking Entrance, across street from the Smithville Historic Cemetery 640 East Moss Mill Rd. Galloway, NJ.





- 6. Next light turn left to continue on 617 W.
- 7. Turn left at light onto 40 W/Harding Hwy.
- 8. Turn right at light past McDonalds onto 559 N Detour/Mill St/616 N
- 9. Turn left onto 559 N. (before closed bridge)
- 10. Turn right into Lake Lenape Atlantic County Park,

RESET ODOMETER TO ZERO


- 11. Exit park, turn right
- 12. Turn right on Weymouth Rd. 559 N.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

COVID-19 Update: WAWA, Lake Lenape, Batsto Village and Smithville require that masks be worn inside any buildings, and outside when social distancing is not possible. The bathrooms at Lake Lenape are inside the boat house, so please wear your mask. The bathrooms at Batsto Village also require a mask, as do the buildings that are open for display.
