## **TOUR DIRECTIONS**

**Meeting Point: Pt. 40 Diner, 761 US-40 (Pole Tavern Circle), Monroeville, NJ.  
PARKING LOT BEHIND THE RESTAURANT**

- 1. Set your trip odometers to "0"**
- 2. Left out of Diner onto Rt. 77**
- 3. Enter Pole Tavern Circle and take 2<sup>nd</sup> Exit onto Monroeville Rd.**
- 4. At 5.6 miles turn Left onto Buck Rd. (You will pass Lake Garrison).**
- 5. At 7.0 miles, turn Left onto Elk Rd.**
- 6. At 11.6 miles, turn Right onto Ellis Mill Rd.**
- 7. At 14.6 miles, turn Right onto Aura Rd, (Rt. 667).**
- 8. At 16.2 miles, turn Left onto Whig Lane Rd. (Abandoned Garage on  
Corner)**
- 9. At 17.3 miles, make Left back onto Buck Rd.**
- 10. Buck Rd. turns into Main St. in Glassboro.**
- 11. At 19.8 miles, turn Right onto West St./Rt. 322.**
- 12. At 19.9 miles, turn Left onto Delsea Dr./Rt. 47 (We will pull over and  
regroup here until everyone makes it through the lights)**

- 13. At 20.4 miles, turn Right onto Greentree Rd.**
- 14. At 22.6 miles, turn Left into Washington Lake Park. Park your cars in Lot E by the Gazebo. Restrooms are located in Lot D, Pavilion A in the Concession Stand. PLEASE OBSERVE ALL PARK RULES. ENJOY THE WALKING TRAILS, HANG OUT IN THE GAZEBO, OR WATCH A LOCAL SPORTS GAME.**
- 15. Left out of Park onto Hurffville-Crosskeys Rd.**
- 16. Stay on Hurffville-Crosskeys Rd. Go Straight through the light at Delsea Dr. onto Sewell Rd.**
- 17. At 25.5 miles, turn Left onto Salina Rd.**
- 18. At 26.3 miles, turn Left onto Blackwood-Barnsboro Rd.**
- 19. Blackwood-Barnsboro Rd. becomes Breakneck Rd. (Steep hills on this road).**
- 20. At 31.2 miles, turn Right onto Cedar Rd. (Clearview High School).**
- 21. At 34.3 miles, turn Right onto Kings Hwy.**
- 22. At 37.3 miles, turn Right onto Parkville Station Rd.**
- 23. At 39.0 miles, turn Right onto Rt. 45 (AT&T Store).**
- 24. At 40.0 miles, Dippy's Ice Cream is on the Left across from AutoZone.**

## **WASHINGTON LAKE PARK**

### **RULES**

While in park areas all persons shall conduct themselves in a proper and orderly manner, and in particular no person shall:

**A.**

Possess alcoholic beverage in park areas or consume the same while there, or be under the influence of intoxicating liquor while there.

**B.**

Enter into, loiter or remain in any part, structure or section thereof which may be reserved and designated for the use of the opposite sex. Exceptions made for children under six years of age.

**C.**

Solicit alms or contributions for any purpose, whether public or private.

**D.**

Build or attempt to build a fire except in such areas and under such regulations as may be designated. No person shall drop, throw or otherwise scatter lighted matches, burning cigarettes or cigars, tobacco paper or other inflammable material within park areas or on any highway, road or street abutting or contiguous thereto.

**E.**

Enter an area posted as "Closed to the Public," nor shall any person use or abet the use of any area in violation of posted notices, including, but not limited to, parking in areas designated for the handicapped.

**F.**

Gamble or participate in or abet any games of chance.

**G.**

Sleep or protractedly lounge on the seats or benches, or engage in loud, boisterous, threatening, abusive, insulting or indecent language, or engage in any disorderly conduct or behavior tending to a breach of the public peace.

**H.**

Expose or offer for sale any article or thing, nor shall any person station or place any stand, cart or vehicle for the transportation, sale or display of any such articles or things, without prior written consent.

**I.**

Paste, glue, tack or otherwise post any sign, placard, advertisement or inscription whatever, except as may be authorized.

**J.**

Cook, grill or otherwise prepare any whole animals or animal heads. The foregoing prohibition shall include any meat products, such as beef, lamb, pork, or any other animal. Cooking and grilling of poultry (without heads), fish and prebutchered or prepackaged meats shall be allowed.

## HISTORICAL PLACE OF NOTE TO LOOK FOR ALONG THE TOUR ROUTE

### DEATH OF THE FOX INN

The Gloucester Fox Hunting Club sometimes ended the chase at this inn. If you visit it, you may hear echoes of the voices of Jonas Cattell, who was the spotter for the club (who warned the soldiers of Fort Mercer at Red Bank that over 1200 Hessian soldiers were approaching to take over the fort); of [Samuel Nicholas](#), the first president of that Club, who also was the first officer of the U.S. Marines; of [Jeffrey Clark](#), for whom the area of Clarksboro is named; [Dr. Bodo Otto, Jr.](#), Colonel in George Washington's army, and stationed with him at Valley Forge, and who died in this house; Daniel Coleman who frequented the tavern, and went on to become Secretary of State (of NJ). All of these people fought for US, so that we would have the liberties and freedoms we now enjoy. LET US NOT FORGET THEM!

Taverns during the 1700's were not just drinking places--patriots gathered here to transact business and to forge what became the future of not only East Greenwich, but also our nation. The people who met in this tavern were instrumental in the birth of our nation. Not all significant events happened across the Delaware River in Philadelphia. **HISTORY WAS MADE HERE!**
