



MAXIMUM CARGO WEIGHTS

The California Vehicle Code (section 35550-35558) limits the amount of weight that we can transport. Often times, the maximum cargo weight listed on an ocean container is much greater than the maximum cargo weight that we would be able to transport on California roads.

The following chart will give you a basic idea of the weight we can legally carry. The weight restrictions are different based upon container sizes and equipment tare weights. The weights listed below are the maximum weights we can legally have on each axles. These maximum weights include the weight of the tractor, container, chassis and cargo. To make it simple, we have listed the maximum weights for container size.
