

SAM STRANGIS, Executive Producer

Biography

A 30-year veteran of television and film production, Sam Strangis is executive producer, with his son Greg Strangis, on WAR OF THE WORLDS, the science-fiction adventure series distributed by Paramount Domestic Television. As a director, producer and production executive, Strangis has been involved with some of the most acclaimed series in television history.

He has directed numerous television shows, including "Wagon Train," "The Restless Gun" and "Batman." Among his work as a producer, Strangis produced the first season of "The Six Million Dollar Man" for Universal Television.

During an eight-year term as vice president in charge of production for Paramount Television, he had a hand in the making of over 30 TV-movies and feature films, including "The "Godfather," "Love Story" and "The Longest Yard." He also oversaw the success of such classic television series as "Star Trek," "Mission: Impossible," "Happy Days," "The Odd Couple," "Laverne & Shirley," "The Brady Bunch," "Love, American Style" and "Mannix."

On October 4, 1977, Strangis and his son Greg organized their successful independent production company, Ten-Four Productions. Since that time, Strangis has executive-produced numerous television series and movies-of-the-week.
