WAR OF THE WORLDS

New aliens invade U.S. in premiere

HOLLYWOOD — "War of the Worlds," the futuristic science-fiction adventure series, escalates to a hard-edged intensity in its second season in syndication. Premiering Friday at 11:30 p.m. on KOIA, the series will reflect contemporary social problems.

Unlike their predecessors, the newly-arrived aliens are not dependent upon killing humans and taking over their bodies, a method which proved crude and inefficient. Instead, this advanced race of Morthrens has adapted their own bodies to human form in order to live and move freely on Earth. Retaining all memories and characteristics of its human original, the clone takes direction from its alien creators while living, working and playing undetected among other human beings.

"The aliens are more terrifying than ever before because they are in your city — they could be your mayor, your priest, your neighbor, your child," says Andersen.
