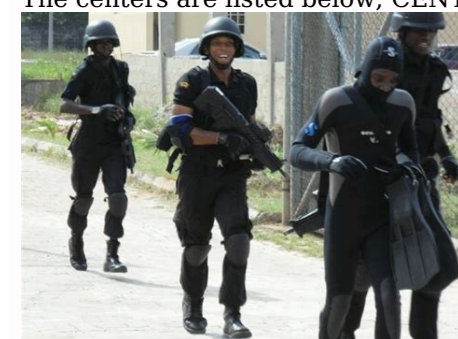

Nigerian Navy Batch 34 Medical Test PROCEDURE ON CONDUCT OF RECRUITMENT MEDICAL EXAMINATION - OFFICERS The Nigerian Navy Medical Board, a board of service medical officers, will conduct a medical examination on a candidate who has been recommended by the Nigerian Navy Selection Board. Only applicants who have been deemed healthy by the medical board will be given consideration for the merit list. Physical Standards for Officers (Male/ Female) on entry The candidate must meet the required standards for fitness. The candidate must be in good physical and mental health and free from any conditions that could hinder effective performance of responsibilities on land and at sea, in both peacetime and a time of war, wherever in the world. During the medical examination of candidates, the following principal points will be ensured:- The candidate is sufficiently intelligent.



The hearing is good and that there is no sign of any disease of ear, nose or throat. Vision in either eye is up to the required standard. His/ her eyes are bright, clear and with no obvious squint or abnormality. Movements of eye balls should be full and free in all directions. Speech is without impediment. There is no glandular swelling. Chest is well-formed and that his/her heart and lungs are sound. Limbs of the candidates are well-formed and fully developed. There is no evidence of hernia of any degree or form. There is free and perfect action of all the joints. Feet and toes are well-formed. Absence of any congenital malformation or defects. He/she does not bear traces of previous acute or chronic disease, pointing to an impaired constitution. Presence of sufficient number of sound teeth for efficient mastication. Absence of any disease of the Genito-Urinary tract. All successfully candidates must ensure they do not have any form of drawing/tattoo. NOTE: The Nigerian Navy conducts its NNBTS Recruitment activity in parts or phases; the first stage is the online application process; the second stage, the nationwide written examination for qualifying candidates, is considered the recruitment exercise. Individuals that pass the exam or aptitude test move on to the third phase, which is the screening and selection interview, in order to further pick the most qualified and best candidates for the final selection training, which is the ultimate stage of the Nigerian Navy's hiring process. The selection interview would take place simultaneously at each of the centers from December 17, 2023, through January 7, 2023. Exams for the oral and written portions of the interview will comprise screening and verification of the candidate's credentials and certifications. Candidates are urged to show up at the centers a day in advance of the scheduled screening and interview. Candidates will be permitted at the screening and interview location even if they do not participate in the 2023 aptitude test or examination. Candidates must have the following items with them: Originals and photocopies of their credentials. Originals and photocopies of valid Drivers' Licence (Category H only). Original and photocopy of State of Origin/LGA certificate. National Identity Card/Acknowledgment Slip. Writing materials. Two pairs of navy blue shorts and 2 white (unmarked) T-Shirts. A pair of canvas/trainers and stockings. Bedsheets and pillowcases. Set of cutlery. Four (4) recent 30X30mm passport-sized photographs on white background. Face masks and hand sanitizers. Personal Toiletries (Bathing and washing soaps, Tooth Paste and brush, etc.). Each candidate will have a one-on-one interview, and if any required criteria are found to be lacking, the candidate's candidacy will be terminated at any point during the interview. If any information or a statement made by a candidate at any point throughout the selection process is discovered to be false, fictitious, or incorrect, that candidate's candidacy would be revoked, and that candidate may be turned over to the Nigeria Police Force for possible legal action. Failing to accurately disclose any applicant's medical history during the whole selection process as specified on the Medical Examination Even if already employed by the Service, pro forma, will result in an automatic withdrawal from training and termination. Candidates will lose their chance to be selected if they don't show up for screening on the

designated date for their Batch at the center designated for their State of Origin. Everyone involved has to take note and act appropriately. Please take note that the Nigerian Navy Batch 35 Recruitment Exercise has a set date. According to the information we have, the Navy Recruitment Screening and Interview will take place between December 17 and January 23.
