GOOD CATCH WINNER

Thomas Wroblewski from the **Orlando-Maitland** crew demonstrated strong situational awareness when an alligator surfaced approximately 100 feet from his crew. By quickly recognizing the potential hazard, he helped ensure the team stayed alert and maintained a safe distance.

This is a great example of how staying aware of your surroundings—especially in dynamic or unpredictable environments—can prevent incidents before they occur.
