	Slab Leveling for 153-158 – PMG presented bids from three vendors to conduct this work. The scope and detail of the bids varied greatly, and the most thorough bid with the greatest scope of work (to include piers under the center of the slab) was selected. Due to the hazard presented to the slab by adjacent trees, root guards were also discussed, as well as pricing a subterranean drip irrigation system to keep the slab and surrounding soil moist and stable.
