GET READY FOR INCREASED ELECTRICITY CHARGES

Unfortunately, with the higher temperatures, also come higher electricity charges. Today, we received the bulk electric bill from CPS, which was 50% higher than last month's bill. This means unit owners can expect roughly the same 50% increase on the individual unit's bills, which should be posted by the 20^{th} of this month.

During the months of June through September, we will also see additional charges due to the "peak capacity charge" which covers the higher costs for electricity that CPS incurs during summer months when demand for electricity is at its highest.

Use ceiling or standing fans and when possible, try to limit using appliances such as electric stoves or dryers during the hot afternoon hours.

RESERVE FUND UPDATE - WEEK OF 5-27-24 thru 6-2-24

In the interest of transparency, in this and each future newsletter, we will list any contributions to, or expenses paid from, the Reserve Fund during the previous week, along with the beginning and ending balance of the Reserve Fund.

A reminder that the entire amount of the 6% dues increase which was effective in February 2024 (\$5,625.00) will be deposited into the Reserve Account each month for a total of \$67,500 by fiscal year-end.
