

Rules & Regulations:

Keeping and maintaining no more than two (2) small orderly domestic pets with a recommended weight up to 35 pound each (i.e. small dogs, cats, caged birds, etc.) shall be permitted within a unit.

- The occupant shall be responsible for any property damage, including soiled foyers and common areas, caused by a pet.
- While outside the unit, pets shall be leashed and attended by a responsible person.
- Occupants are responsible for removing waste matter from common areas, limited common areas, and units.



- No DRONE flying is permitted within the complex


