Amazon Application Pre-requisites

1. AMAZON PROFESSIONAL SELLER ACCOUNT:

You must have a professional amazon seller account in order to apply for developer profile.

2. APPLY FOR AMAZON DEVELOPER PROFILE:

In order to run the application and operate over your account, it needs Amazon API Keys. These keys can be obtained through Amazon Developer Profile. The procedure for applying for developer profile is as under:

- a) Go to sellercentral and navigate to Develop Apps. Click Developer profile link.
- b) Fill your company information and select Application type as "Private".
- If you need to download orders along with buyer name and email/phone (Personal Identifiable Information) PII, then you may need to check "Direct-to-Consumer". When you check this, amazon will give you a long form with technical questions which will be needed to answer according to Amazon Policy. This process is lengthy and need more professional way to get approval. So if you don't really need to process orders along with buyer name and phone, then don't check this option, as you will still be able to download orders without PII. NOTE: We recommend not applying for PII on your first pass (3 items in the list highlighted in red). This process for approval can take some time and even multiple attempts to get PII approval. To get started you can register without PII, get the app running and downloading orders. Then revisit the registration page and try for PII. If you are downloading FBA orders only, you don't need PII, Amazon does not provide buyer name and address with FBA thru SP-API even if you have the approval. PII should be considered for FBM only and only if absolutely necessary based on the time and complexity of getting approval.

- d) If you need TAX invoicing or Remittance, you may check those too, however, these two are also under PII category you will need to proceed with same questions as "Direct-to-Consumer".
- e) Once you have filled the form, and wait for amazon answer, if you have applied for PII, you will need to fight for a couple of weeks, or else, you will be granted approval very soon. Without PII developer approval may only take a couple hours.
- f) Once you have been granted access, then you may create an App on the same panel from where you have applied for developer profile. See Create App section

3. SIGN UP FOR AMAZON WEB SERVICES ACCOUNT:

We need to create users, plicies, roles etc to set permission for SP-API calls/operations. For this purpose, we need to signup with amazon aws account.

- a) Signup here: https://portal.aws.amazon.com/billing/signup
- b) Setup User, Role, Policies etc following this document. https://developer-docs.amazon.com/sp-api/docs/creating-and-configuring-iam-policies-and-entities
- c) When you complete the steps, you should three Keys (AccessKey, SecretKey and ARN). We will need to use these keys in our Desktop Application.

4. CREATE APP:

We need to create an app on the sellercentral to get Amazon Keys. The app does not need any coding or programming skill. It is only a form filling. Please follow the given steps below.

a) Sign into Seller Central using your developer credentials and navigate to Develop Apps.

- b) On the Developer Central page, choose Add new app client.
- c) Complete the form. (You can give the app any name, it is simply providing an entry you will need for the setup screen of EZOrderLink_AMTU3)
- d) You should now have an App in the draft status, that's enough for you.
- e) Get keys, AppID, LWA -> Client and Secret.
- f) Generate Refresh Token. Click on the Authorize button and generate Refresh Token.

5. GET SELLER ID:

The easiest way to get Seller ID is to go to your sellercentral ->inventory and click on one of your ASIN. You should see SellerID="your id" in the address bar. Copy that and save.

We should now have the following Keys.

1.	AccessKev	(obtained in step-3)	step-3)

2. SecretKey (obtained in step-3)

3. Role-ARN (obtained in step-3)

4. LWA_AccessKey (obtained in step-4)

5. LWA_SecretKey (obtained in step-4)

6. AppID (obtained in step-4)

7. RefreshToken (obtained in step-4)

8. SellerID (obtained in step-5)

9. Region-ID (It can be either "us-east-1" for US region OR "eu-west-1" for Europe)

10. MarketplaceID (Select relevant Marketplace from the Settings).

Installation:

- 1. Unzip the setup_EZOrderLink_AMTU3.zip file
- 2. Run Setup.exe


