When we receive a donation the office sends out an acknowledgement letter to the donor.

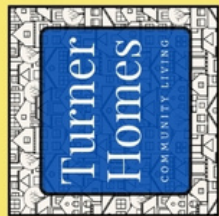

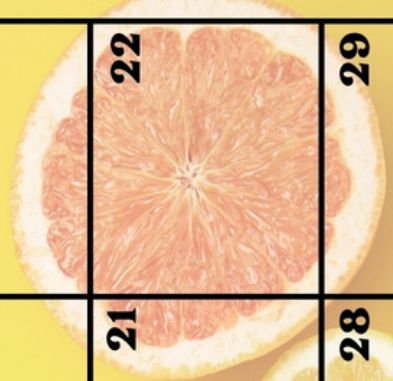
