JUNE PolNeed to Consider Assisted Livings

You may be thinking, do I even need to consider the question "Do I need to consider assisted living?" Well, let me say it's something you should consider if you want to keep living your best quality of life for as long as you can. We all know that change can be difficult, especially when we are in a comfortable spot and see no need for change, but change happens if we acknowledge it or not. Making the right choice could be detrimental to your quality of your life.

I also want to say on behalf of all of us here at Turner Homes, that we enjoy having you here as a part of the Turner Homes community, but if you are struggling to live here on your own and are finding it difficult to handle daily tasks, we would rather see you in an environment that will help you thrive instead of the alternative of not getting the help you may need when you need it and having something terrible happen.

Let's start by taking a moment to check off some of the questions that you can use to determine where you are when it comes to making this important decision.

- 1. Do you find your personal daily tasks becoming more difficult to accomplish? This would be things like showering and bathing, getting dressed or undressed, and taking care of your daily personal needs.
- 2. Do you sometimes get confused managing your medications and taking them on time?

- 3. Are you able to take care of your household chores? Cleaning your home; vacuuming, mopping, scrubbing the toilet and the tub, and doing your laundry? What about doing the yard
- 4. Are you able to shop independently and make your own healthy meals and manage your diet?
- 5. Are you having trouble walking or keeping your balance? Have you taken any falls or are you concerned about falling?
- 6. Do you continuing to get out and be active, or do you feel isolated because you are not able to get out and socialize?
- 7. Are you starting to take on the daily tasks of being a caregiver to your spouse to help them with their daily personal needs?

If you answered yes to a few of these questions, then it's time to consider that next step. Maybe it's not assisted living you need. Maybe having the help of nearby family to assist with some of the tasks would help. Maybe hiring someone to come in and help you with some of the tasks mentioned would help. (Here's a nod towards our housekeeping service, and also the Café for a meal once a day.) Or, maybe it's time to really consider a move to an assisted living facility. We have information in the office you can stop by and pick up, or even make an appointment to talk to Tim. He may have a suggestion or two on how to help you take the next step.
