



Percent of Births Attended by CNMs - 2013





Where CNMs and CMs Practice





Map of Mass Hospitals offering






Mass CNM Retirement Projections

Next Steps to Increase the Use of Nurse Midwives and to Build the Workforce in Massachusetts

Actualize full practice authority	Ensure that the practice environment allows nurse midwives to practice to the full extent of their education and training.
Hospital Privileges and Medical Staff Participation	If you don't already have them, apply for hospital privileges and to be included in the medical staff.
Midwifery/ Physician Collaboration	Support CNM/CM-MD partnerships to provide appropriate care to all women. Document your productivity and cost effectiveness to the partnership.
Create educational opportunities for nurse midwifery education	Introduce state legislation to support/fund a nurse midwifery education. Work with a state funded educational program to establish a nurse midwifery educational program
