
Artwork Drop Off Date/Time: Artwork must be delivered to Collective Coffee Thursday, October 23rd between 4-6pm. Either students, parents, or teachers can drop artwork off at the venue. All work must be labeled and ready to hang. *If you are unable to drop your artwork off on the designated date/time, please contact Show Chair Oshi Sanyal mckinneyartclubevents@gmail.com to make arrangements ahead of time to schedule an alternate drop off date/time.


Artwork Requirements:


2D Work (Painting, Drawing, Photography, etc.)


- Matting: Mats are required and must be black, white, or off-white.
- Framing: Frames are optional.
- If you are not using a traditional frame and are matting only, please mount your matted work to foam board and wire the back for hanging. *Please see (A.) on the next page for reference.
- Hanging: All pieces must be wired and ready to hang no sawtooth hangers or clip systems. *Please see (B.) on the next page for reference or view a tutorial on how to wire artwork here. Labeling: A label is required for each piece. Please affix it to the back, top right corner using tape or double stick tape.
- Size Limit: Maximum overall dimensions of 18" x 24", including mat, frame, and/or mounting materials.













3D Work (Sculpture, Assemblage, Installation, etc.)

- Must be structurally sound, stable, and suitable for indoor display (unless otherwise specified).
- Must be fully assembled or require only minimal assembly on-site.
- Size Approval: Works measuring 3 feet or larger in any dimension require prior approval.
- Restrictions: No perishable, combustible, or live components accepted without written pre-approval.
- Labeling: A label is required for each piece and must be securely attached to your piece.

Oversized Artwork: Anything larger than 18" x 24" for 2D artwork and 3 feet for 3D artwork is deemed oversized. To ensure that your item can be appropriately accommodated for the show, please contact Show Chair Oshi Sanyal mckinneyartclubevents@gmail.com.

Where to Shop for Wiring Supplies: Home Depot, Lowe's, Hobby Lobby, Jerry's Artarama, Michaels, or Amazon

What You'll Need: Wire cutters, D-rings (choose size based on the weight of your artwork), screws, and picture hanging wire. *Tip: Consider purchasing a pre-made wiring kit-it's convenient and includes everything you need in one package.

Artwork Pick Up Date/Time: All artwork must be picked up at Collective Coffee on Sunday, November 2nd between 12-2pm. Any work that is not picked up will incur a \$10/day storage fee. If you are unable to pick up your work at the designated date/time, please contact Show Chair Oshi Sanyal mckinneyartclubevents@gmail.com to make arrangements ahead of time to schedule an alternate pick up date/time.

Donation: If for any reason you are unable to pick up your artwork, or would prefer not to, you can donate it to the Art Club of McKinney so that it can be utilized in a raffle or auction. If you opt to donate, please let us know by emailing Show Chair, Oshi Sanyal at mckinneyartclubevents@gmail.com. We thank you and assure you that your piece will be handled with care.
