The 5th annual 2026 Art Meets Poetry Exhibit is open to the public from Friday, February 6th – Saturday, February 14th, at Collective Coffee 301 W Louisiana St Suite 200, McKinney, TX 75069. The exhibit is open during **regular business hours**.

- Art & Poetry Showcase: Saturday, Feb 7th 12-6pm CST (venue TBA) where artists and poets present their pairings, sharing inspiration and process. The showcase schedule will be posted online and emailed to participants prior to the weekend. *Invite friends and family!*

Eligibility

Open to artists and poets with a Texas connection.

Membership in the Art Club of McKinney or the Mockingbird Poetry Society is **not required**.

Goals

• **Connect** Texas-affiliated artists and poets from every discipline, style, and background.



- **Inspire** new ways of seeing and feeling. As Leonardo da Vinci said: "Painting is poetry that is seen rather than felt, and poetry is painting that is felt rather than seen."
- **Fundraise** via a raffle of an original artwork; **all proceeds** benefit local charities that assist individuals and families facing food emergencies.

Exhibit Concept

A collaborative platform for **emerging and established** artists and poets to create dialogue and share fresh perspectives with each other and the community.

Theme & Content

- Open theme (artist/poet's choice)
- Family-friendly: art and/or poetry that is overtly violent, political, racist, sexist, or sexually explicit will not be accepted.

How AMP Works

Phase 1 — Submit Original Work

- What: Original poetry or art (you must own the rights)
- Limits: Max 1 submission
- Fee: \$5
- Deadline: Saturday, Nov 15th 11:59pm CST
- Submission/Payment: https://form.jotform.com/252736278865068

What happens next: After the deadline, all eligible Phase 1 entries are posted in online galleries (one for poetry, one for art) for Phase 2 participants to review.



Submitting in Phase 1 does **not** guarantee your work will be selected or included in the exhibition.

Option to pay the fee by check:

- Make payable to Art Club of McKinney; note "2026 Art Meets Poetry" in the memo.
- Mail to P.O. Box 243, McKinney, TX 75070.
- Entry fees must be received or postmarked by Wednesday, January 14. Fees support program administration and are non-refundable.

Phase 2 — Select & Interpret (Pairings for the Show)

- Selection window: Monday, Nov 17th Saturday, Dec 13th 11:59pm CST
- You **do not** need to have submitted in Phase 1 in order to participate in Phase 2.
- How it works:
 - 1. Review the Phase 1 art and poetry galleries:

2. Email the **ID/number** of the piece you want to interpret to **Barry Rynk** (Mockingbird Poetry Society AMP Chair) at



<u>ArtMeetsPoetryProgram@gmail.com</u> to **reserve** it. No entries are pre-assigned for interpretation. Reservations are **first come**, **first served** once Phase 2 opens.

- 3. **Limits:** You may reserve **ONLY one poem OR one artwork**. You **cannot** interpret your **own** work.
- 4. Interpretation Defined

Interpretation = your personal response.

It's about how the work makes *you* feel—what you notice, imagine, or connect with—rather than the creator's original intent. **Literal interpretations are welcome too** if that's your choice.

- → Artists: Choose a poem and create a new artwork inspired by your reaction (mood, imagery, memory, color, rhythm). It can be expressive or literal—your call.
- → **Poets:** Choose an artwork and write a new poem based on your own emotional/creative response (tone, shapes, story you sense). It can be exploratory or **literal**—your choice.
- Exhibition outcome: The pair (original Phase 1 work + your interpretation) will be shown together at Art Meets Poetry 2026.
- After confirmation: Once Barry confirms your reservation, begin creating your interpretive piece. Please read the full prospectus for all guidelines.
- Reservation deadline: Saturday, Dec 13th 11:59pm CST

Phase 3 — Submit Your Interpretive Piece

- What to submit: Your <u>finished</u> interpretive poem or artwork
- How: Complete the Phase 3 form and upload your file: https://form.jotform.com/252736510984160



• Fee: \$5 (1 submission only)

Deadline: Saturday, Jan 24th 11:59pm CST

Art Guidelines

- All entries must be original in concept and rendering by the submitting artist and not shown in prior Art Meets Poetry exhibits.
- No wet artwork accepted.
- Works containing text are considered **art** (not poetry) for this program.
- 2D artwork: framed or gallery-wrapped; clean finished edges; wired for hanging (no sawtooth hangers).
- Max size (2D): 24 × 36 in framed.
- Liability: The Art Club, Mockingbird Poetry Society, and venue are not responsible for glass breakage, damage, or theft.
- 3D artwork: must be stable and self-supporting (table/platform) or framed for hanging; combined H+W+D ≤ 70 in.
 - Oversized pieces require **prior approval** (space permitting). Contact **Kathryn Iklé** at **theartclubofmckinney@gmail.com** or call/text **901-240-1628**.
- Labels: Complete and affix to each work (back upper-right for 2D; base for 3D). Labels are on the last page of the prospectus.
- Art will not be accepted unless properly wired and labeled.
- **Copyright:** Artists retain copyright; once accepted, images may enter the Art Club of McKinney and Mockingbird Poetry Society archives and may be used in publicity or in future published materials for Art Meets Poetry.
- Tastefulness & acceptance are at the discretion of the Art Club President and Mockingbird Poetry Society. Work that is overtly violent, political, racist, sexist, or sexually explicit will not be accepted.



Poetry Guidelines

- All poems must be **in English**, the **original** work of the submitting poet, and **not** shown in prior AMP exhibits.
- Any style or form is welcome.
- Length: body of poem ≤ 24 lines (title and one-line epigraph not counted).
- Line width: ≤ 60 characters (incl. spaces/punctuation); applies to titles, subtitles, epigraphs, dedications, footnotes.
- Typeface: Times New Roman, 12 pt preferred. Editors may standardize formatting for display.
- **Published status:** Unpublished **and** previously published poems accepted (provide first-publication info on the form for previously published work).
- Interpretive poems (Phase 3): Include an epigraph beneath the title crediting the original artwork (artist name + artwork title).
- **Copyright:** Poets retain copyright; once accepted, works may enter organizational archives and be used in publicity.
- No retractions after submission.
- Tastefulness & acceptance are at the discretion of Mockingbird Poetry Society and the Art Club President. Work that is overtly violent, political, racist, sexist, or sexually explicit will not be accepted.

Artwork Sale & Pick-Up

- You may price your art for sale. Sales are between artist and buyer; the Art Club, Mockingbird Poetry Society, and venue are not parties to the sale.
- Interested buyers will contact the artist using the **label** info.
- Pre-sold work must remain on view for the duration of the exhibit.



- Artists are responsible for sales tax reporting to the State of Texas.
- Late pick-up may incur a \$10/day storage charge. The organizations/venue are not responsible for uncollected art.
