Speech and Language Therapy Mini-tender - Allen Speech & Language Ltd.

A new short-term service

We wanted to let you know that a new speech and language service has been commissioned on a six-month contract to provide extra capacity to meet the needs of children.

The provider is called Allen Speech & Language Ltd. and they will provide several speech and language therapists to deliver some interventions with children.

Issues of concern raised by parent/carers and some colleagues

This note sets out to acknowledge the disappointment that some families and schools may have that their child/ren are not benefitting from this service. The aim of this commission is to increase capacity in the short term and see how the model of a new private provider works to meet need.

Reason this short-term service is being provided

All the stakeholders understand there are long term plans to commission a major new contract for therapies in relation to SEND. This short-term arrangement is a trial using a new provider and increases capacity whilst the replacement contract is prepared.

Developing the new long-term contract

Whilst a great deal of engagement and consultation has been provided by stakeholders previously, this still needs work to develop the contract. Some examples of work that needs to be completed and signed off includes: an Equalities Impact Assessment, a specification and approvals needs to be agreed by both the ICB and the council. Once completed tendering, a selection process, appointment and mobilisation all need to be completed in a few short months.

As the stages develop there will be opportunities to engage and comment on the design of the service. The current timeline for the mobilisation of the new main contract is targeting a date in January 2024.

Internship opportunities for young autistic people and people with learning disabilities - Beginning in September 2023

What are supported internships?

Supported internships are a one-year work-based study programme, where young people spend the majority of their time based at an employer.

They provide an important step on the employment journey, helping young people aged 16 to 24 with an Education, Health and Care plan (EHCP) or another form of Special Educational Needs (SEN) support to get the skills they need for work so they can get into a job.

Paid employment for adults is a key determinant of good health, and the natural supports that come with employed status are paramount in enabling people to cope with the challenges they face as they go through adulthood.

The commitment in the NHS Long Term Plan

The [NHS Long Term Plan](#) says that: 'We will continue to offer more opportunities for people with a learning disability and for people with autism. Supported Internship opportunities targeted at people with a learning disability and/or autism will increase by 2023/24, with at least half converted to paid employment over the first five years of the Long-Term Plan. The number of NHS internship and employment programmes/sites delivered through 'Project Search' and 'Project Choice' will increase as will the number of NHS organisations making the Learning Disability Employment Programme Pledge.'

Wellington House will be host to a wide range of intern opportunities across the building, for young autistic people and people with learning disabilities, starting in September 2023. This internship programme aims to provide an opportunity for young people to gain valuable first-time experience in a workplace environment and to gain a wide range of skills across multiple different teams.

As part of the programme, we will host an internship information session on Friday 21 July at 12pm. This session will cover all aspects of the internship, how it works, the day-to-day aspects of the internship and the overall aims of the programme.
