This academic framework is fully aligned with the official **Occupational Standard for Numerologists – Code COR 516102**, established in European Union - Romania in 2023 and recognised under the European Qualifications Framework (EQF). Each academic year consists of **1,080 hours** of combined theory and practice, matching the rigour and intensity of accredited European university-level studies.

The full six-year programme exceeds **6,400 contact hours**, positioning the **Master Numerologist®** diploma as an equivalent to postgraduate-level studies, comparable to an **MBA Master's Degree**. No upper age limit or prior diploma is required for entry, as long as the applicant has completed at least 12 years of general education and possesses basic communication and numeracy skills.

Certified Numerologist®

Overview

The Certified Numerologist® programme lays the foundation for structured numerological practice. It introduces students to the principles of numeric archetypes, personal charts, and life cycles. The year focuses on building fluency in symbolic language, numeric interpretation, and structured analysis.

Counsellor Numerologist®

Overview

The Counsellor Numerologist® diploma deepens the analytical and interpersonal dimension of numerology. Students learn to guide others through life decisions, emotional clarity, and self-awareness using contextual numeric interpretation.

Starting in Year 2, students also take on a mentorship role by supporting Certified Numerologist® candidates (Year 1). Each Counsellor Numerologist® is required to guide at least three first-year students throughout their foundational training. This guided mentorship is an integral part of the Year 2 practicum and final evaluation.

Key Topics

- Numeric support in behavioural and emotional dynamics
- Communication frameworks and vibrational listening
- Numeric negotiation and conflict harmonisation
- Organisational analysis and energy structuring
- Professional consultancy structure and ethics

Coach Numerologist®

Overview

The Coach Numerologist® programme is dedicated to those who have completed the Trainer level and wish to explore transformative coaching through structured numerological development.



The core of the programme is built around **O 9 Ființă® – The New Being Programme**, based on psycho-numerological principles. It includes nine transformative chapters, studied over nine months, and is supported by three complementary modules in applied numerology.

Students will examine the origins, methods, philosophical principles, and symbolic correspondences of traditional numerology schools from diverse cultures, integrating them into a coherent framework for advanced application.
