Programme Structure

- 2. Counsellor Numerologist
- 3. Trainer Numerologist
- 4. Coach Numerologist (available from 2026)
- 5. Professor Numerologist (available from 2027)
- 6. Master Numerologist (available from 2028)

- Advanced counselling and client support methodologies

Methodology & Assessment

All programmes are delivered through Open and Distance Learning (ODL), including:

- Live video sessions
- Asynchronous modules and reading materials
- Guided practical exercises
- Supervised client work

Each year includes two formal assessments (intermediate and final), with continuous feedback and self-paced milestones. Learners interact with certified trainers, mentors, and assessors throughout the process.

Certification & Professional Relevance

Oxford Numerology University® grants a diploma after each academic year. All certifications are aligned with the European Occupational Standard for Numerologists (COR 516102), which defines the competencies and scope of practice at each professional level. Graduates may work independently or in multidisciplinary teams, and are encouraged to contribute to research and publication initiatives supported by the university.
