This document outlines the international expansion strategy of Oxford Numerology University®, under the legal authority of Oxford Numerology Society (UK), detailing the institution's planned linguistic, legal, and territorial growth from 2025 to 2035. It reflects our commitment to transnational access, multilingual delivery, and the academic integration of the EU-recognised Occupational Standard for Numerologists – Code COR 516102 – across multiple jurisdictions.

2025

- Launch of international accreditation processes (IPHM, CPD, IICT, AADP, AHP, IACT, APQN, AAOU)
- Institutional positioning formalised through academic documentation and university governance
- Full academic programme published and made available in English and Romanian

2026

- First cohort for **Coach Numerologist** diploma (Year 4)
- Curriculum available in Spanish
- Legal expansion into Spain completed
- Launch of the EU Standard COR 516102 accreditation process in Spain

2027

- First cohort for Professor Numerologist diploma (Year 5)
- Curriculum available in French
- Legal expansion into France completed
- Launch of the EU Standard COR 516102 accreditation process in France

2028

- First cohort for Master Numerologist diploma (Year 6)
- Curriculum available in Italian
- Legal expansion into Italy completed
- Launch of the EU Standard COR 516102 accreditation process in Italy



2029

- Completion and release of the documentary film:
 - "God Speaks to Us Through Numbers"

2030

- Publication of the academic and cultural cornerstone work:
 - "The Encyclopaedic Compendium of Numerology" (12 volumes – one dedicated to each core number)

2031

• Opening of the Numerological Statistics & Research Data Centre, a fully digitised research platform dedicated to collecting, analysing, and publishing numerical behavioural data.

2032

- Publication of three thematic volumes:
 - "Numerology of the World's Wealthiest"
 - "Numerology of Famous Couples"
 - "Numerology of the Great Thinkers"

- 10-Year Anniversary of Oxford Numerology University®
- Hosting of the First World Congress of Numerologists, held in Oxford
