



GSA Schedule Set Asides

Government Agencies can now set-aside GSA Schedule orders for Service-Disabled, Veteran Owned Businesses. The new rule greatly simplifies the acquisition process.

Interim rule for FAR Case 2011-024, effective Nov. 2, 2011, provides agencies with the ability to set aside orders and Blanket Purchase Agreements (BPAs) issued under Multiple Award Schedules (MAS) program to Service-Disabled, Veteran-Owned Small Businesses (SDVOSB).

Set-Aside orders for SDVOSBs have no order limitations. This differs from 8(a), Women-Owned Small Businesses (WOSB) or Economically Disadvantaged Women-Owned Small Businesses (EDWOSB) that have certain order limitations.
