The FBI Youth Academy at Broward College Central (main) Campus is a prestigious learning community geared towards educating high school students about the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Broward College's School of Justice degree programs, and other related Law Enforcement Careers.

The Academy is designed to educate South Florida high school students about the inner workings of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), opportunities available at the Broward College School of Justice, and various local law enforcement career prospects. The FBI Youth Academy affords students a unique opportunity to engage collaboratively with FBI agents, law enforcement personnel, and university professors that foster leadership skills, critical thinking, and team building.

The program consists of 5 days of an intriguing mix of classroom, laboratory, outdoor, and field trip activities that culminate to a Graduation Ceremony on day 5. Students gain a full awareness of the required education and training for specific careers with the FBI and general law enforcement agencies. Conducted on the Broward College-Central Campus, students take part in a diverse schedule that includes formal instruction, scenario-based training, and practical applications. Students are fully immersed in hands-on modules that include mock crime scene investigations, SWAT led hostage recovery, and other activities that emphasize expert investigation techniques.

The FBI Youth Academy is in partnership with the FBI Miami Citizens Academy Alumni Association, Memorial Healthcare, FBI Miami Division, and Broward College.

If you are selected as an FBI Youth Academy Scholarship Recipient you are expected to:

- 1. Attend school every day and be on time and prepared to learn.
- 2. Give advanced notice if late or unable to make class.
- 3. Show respect to colleagues, adults, and property at all times.
- 4. Address all adults as "Sir" "Mr." "Mrs." "Ms." "Special Agent" "Officer" etc.
- 5. No use vulgar, obscene, and derogatory language. ZERO TOLERANCE
- 6. Work to the best of your ability, striving toward the highest level of achievement possible.
- 7. React to direction in a respectful, positive manner.
- 8. Accept responsibility for your actions.
- 9. Conduct yourself as a representative of your family and school, holding yourself to the highest standards of conduct, demeanor, and sportsmanship.
- 10. Alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs are prohibited.
- 11. Refrain from fighting, arguing, or exhibiting violent actions.
- 12. No sleeping during class.
- 13. NO texting or talking on cell phones during class (cell use allowed ONLY at breaks).

As part of our on-going efforts to enhance the program, collect data for future funding, and keep in touch with our scholarship recipients, we will be tracking the education and career goals of each student.

The "Tracking at a Glance" software allows us the opportunity to track students after they graduate the FBI Youth Academy program. Our goal is to determine what impact the program has on a student's academic and career goals.

Students will be tracked over a period of 6-8 years (depending on high school grade level when participating in the program). No social security numbers are retained; however, certain contact and personal information is required (physical address, e-mail, telephone, gender, ethnicity, etc.) Over the tracking period, students will participate in surveys pertaining to academic and career goals. The program will also provide information so that mentoring opportunities and alumni activities can be offered.
