TECH TALK WITH CARL FLOWERS:

Well racing season is just around the corner and not only are the racers and their teams getting ready so are the tracks and all the people that help throughout the year. Fans are ready to smell the fuel hear the noise and watch dirt fly.

For me and all the other techs that I know it seems like racing season never stops. As soon as the season is over, we start looking at rules and the things we have made notes on throughout the year that we need to clarify or change. Many of us spend the winter months answering questions racers may have or rules they may not understand. We spend time in



answering questions racers may have or rules they may not understand. We spend time in some cases traveling to some shops looking at what teams have questions on and help give some direction. But we also have our time to get ourselves ready and all our equipment. We also have tried to keep rules as simple as we can. The thing we do ask racers is try and remember is, we can't cover every nut, bolt, bracket or part on a racecar in the rules, if we did it would look like a NASCAR Rule book and we don't need that at this level of our sport.


