## SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR INDIANA TEAMSTERS DEFINED CONTRIBUTION PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report Form 5500 Annual Return/Report of Employee Benefit Plan of Indiana Teamsters Defined Contribution Plan and Employer Identification Number 88-2227958/Plan Number 001 for the plan year 04/01/2023 through 03/31/2024. The Form 5500 annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA). Your plan is a defined contribution plan with the following characteristics: employer contributions, profit sharing, ERISA section 404(c), total participant-directed account, pre-approved pension.

## **Basic Financial Statement**

Benefits under the plan are provided by a trust fund. Plan expenses were \$276,398. These expenses included \$0 in administrative expenses and \$118,754 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, \$0 in certain deemed and/or corrective distributions, and \$157,644 in other expenses. A total of 1644 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$2,423,164 as of the end of the plan year, compared to \$880,390 as of the beginning of the plan year. During the plan year the plan experienced a change in its net assets of \$1,542,774. This change includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$1,819,172, including employer contributions of \$1,551,595, employee contributions of \$0, other contributions/other income of \$0 and earnings from investments of \$267,577.

## **Information Regarding Plan Assets**

The U.S. Department of Labor's regulations require that an independent qualified public accountant audit the plan's financial statements unless certain conditions are met for the audit requirement to be waived. This plan met the audit waiver conditions for the plan year beginning 04/01/2023 and therefore has not had an audit performed.

The plan's assets were held in individual participant accounts with investments directed by participants and beneficiaries and with account statements from regulated financial institutions furnished to the participant or beneficiary at least annually and other qualifying assets.
