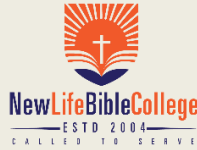

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## 1. BRIEF INTRODUCTION AND HISTORY

The existing Bible College (NLBC) at Dobam village, Arunachal Pradesh, was established back in the year 2004 as New Life Bible Training Institute with the intention to educate the local Christian workers theologically, under the ambit of Arunachal Christian Revival Church Council. The then President of NEIRCRCC, Rev. Dr. Shiwoto Sumi dedicated the college in December 2003. The institution commenced its first academic session on 15 February 2004. It humbly started with fifteen students and few faculty headed by Rev. Tinu Yangba Imchen, and it offered only C. Th. and Dip. Th. Despite numerous challenges, Rev. Tinu Yangba Imchen and his wife unwearingly carried NLBTI ministry since its inception to till 2017.

The need for effective and relevant ministry led NLBTI to offer B. Th. Hence, it has been upgraded to a full-fledged theological college since 2016. Now the College is popularly known as New Life Bible College, and it runs proficiently as Bible College.

2. **MISSION STATEMENT:** The mission of NLBC is to train and equip the men and women of God to be effective and efficient in responding “The Great Commission” in obedience to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
3. **VISION:** We believe that with the help of Almighty God we will produce God-fearing men and women who will impact the people around them by the power of God’s word.

## 9. ACADEMIC INFORMATION

**Academic Year:** It begins in June and ends in March; it includes two semesters and both summer and winter breaks.

**Medium of Instruction:** The medium of instruction will be in English; therefore every student is expected to communicate in it.

**Application Process:** Applicants should collect prospectus from the Academic office at NLBC and fulfill all the requirements mentioned in it at the stipulated time.

**Admission Date:** 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2021.

**Entrance Test:** All applicants must clear the entrance test to get admission in NLBC; it will be conducted during the time of admission.

### Requirements for application:

#### 1. Certificate in Theology

- Must be a baptized member with good testimony in his/her Church.
- Must be clear about his/her divine call.
- Must be in good physical health.
- Must have completed his/her 8<sup>th</sup> class or equivalent.
- Must clear the entrance test.
- Must be above 18 years of age.

#### 2. Diploma in Theology

- Must be a baptized member with good testimony in his/her Church.
- Must be clear about his/her divine call.
- Must be in good physical health.
- Must have completed his/her 10<sup>th</sup> class or equivalent.
- Must clear the entrance test.
- Must be above 18 years of age.



### 3. Bachelor of Theology

- Must be a baptized member with good testimony in his/her Church.
- Must be clear about his/her divine call.
- Must be in good physical health.
- Must have completed his/her 12<sup>th</sup> class or equivalent.
- Must clear the entrance test.
- Must be above 18 years of age.

**Note-** All the forms must be filled completely and properly. In case of any discrepancy in the required documents, applicants will be rejected.

**Distance Education:** It is one new feather added to the NLBC academic programs. It is prepared for people who cannot avail themselves for residential programs. For detail information you can contact the Director of Distance Education.

## 12. STUDENTS' LIFE

**Spiritual life:** The spiritual growth of students is one of the top priorities of the college. The College conducts prayer and fasting programs at the end of every month; on weekdays, students and faculty meet for chapel twice a day. Besides, the college seeks to conduct seminars, spiritual awakening programs, retreats etc.

**Hostel:** The NLBC has hostel facility; it can accommodate all the enrolled students suitably. Therefore, every student is expected to reside in the hostel, except for a few exceptional day scholars. Currently, we do not have separate accommodation for married students.

**Note-** Day scholar option is only for those who are engaged in active ministry and if they prove that they can meet all the academic requirements. And he/she will be required to submit a ministry report to the dean of Practical ministry monthly.

**Practical Training:** Alongside the academic standard, the college seriously concerns for the practical training of students. The college has a Practical ministry department who handles affairs pertaining to the practical training of students. Students get ample opportunities to be involved in practical ministry, such as evangelism and church visitation, where they preach, teach, sing and use their spiritual gifts. We also send our students for internship to different places far and near, where they experience and learn about Christian ministry practically.

**Library:** One new library building construction has been completed recently, which includes all the facilities: Wi-Fi, computers, and resources for deep study. The new building has enough space to study, which can accommodate around 200 students at a time.

Presently, there are more than 3,000 volumes of Books. Thousands of books related to the curriculum are likely to be added shortly.

### **13. FINANCIAL INFORMATION**

The essence of this college is to impart sound biblical knowledge to its students; therefore the college has done its best to minimize the expenses and make it affordable. Therefore, every student is expected to fulfill all the financial requirements of the college.
