Facts and Photo's

We have been made aware that there have been a few cases of Threadworm at Win-

nersh Primary School. Threadworm is a very common occurrence in children. They are

white and look like small pieces of thread. You may notice them around a child's bottom

or in their stools. They don't always cause symptoms but can cause itchiness around the

bottom area which is often worse at night and can cause disturbed sleep. Medication to

treat threadworms is available from pharmacies without prescription. If your child does

have threadworms, everyone in the household will need to be treated even if they have

no symptoms (unless pregnant or breastfeeding). Please visit the www.nhs.uk for further
