
At Greenwood we will be doing a "How did you travel to pre-school" survey.

For those that are getting ready to start school in September, it would helpful to work on the following to get the children school ready!


- Can they recognize their own name?

What sounds can you hear outside today?






Practise your pencil control

Can you use the sheets attached and draw the paths!


# **Traffic Survey**
