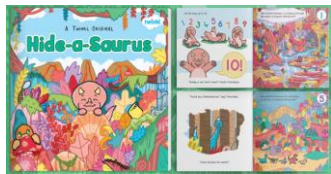
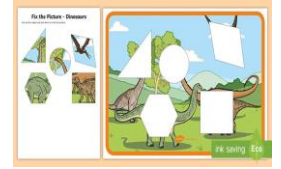




# Dinosaurs

Week Two.

**Monday:** Cutting practice. Grab your scissors for some scissor practice. Use our Dinosaur work sheets or create your own cutting activity.



**Tuesday:** Hide-a-saurus. Enjoy this lovely Dinosaur number story from Twinkle.

**Wednesday:** Shape recognition and colour sheet. Can you find the correct shape and colour it in. Maybe as an extension you could go on a shape hunt around your house. e.g.- a window is a square.



**Thursday:** Dinosaur role and move. Using a dice, match each number to a dinosaur move. Each time you roll a number, move like that Dinosaur.

**Friday:** Story building. Choose yourself a character (maybe a dinosaur if you have one) and make up your own story. Use props from around your house to help you. Maybe build the story with a grown up and take it in turns to add to the story.

Example- One day Dino the Dinosaur went for a walk in the park with his friend. It started to rain so Dino put up his umbrella. Dino and his friend were waiting for the rain to stop so that they could eat their lunch from their lunch boxes.
