

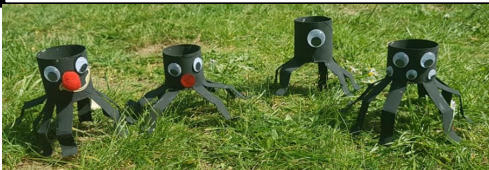
Bug Week

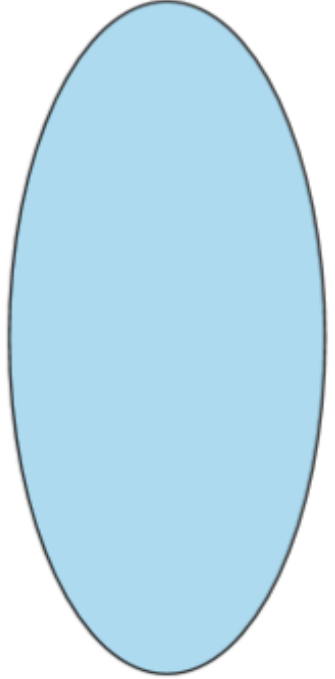
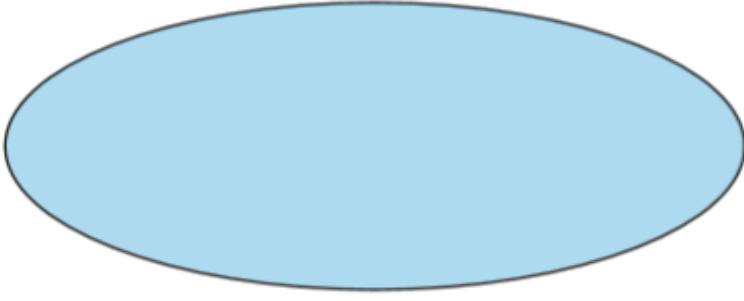
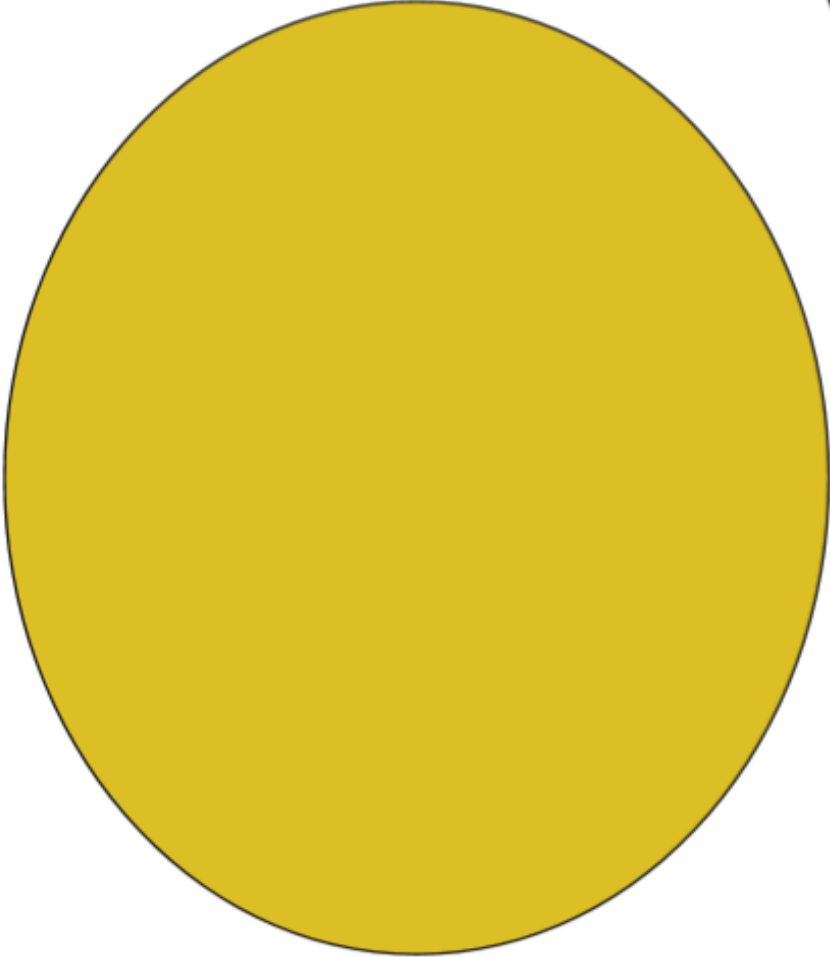
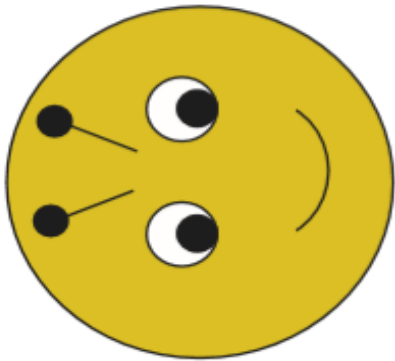
Bug Play dough Prints

Can you cut out the shapes to make your own bee?

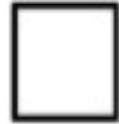
