TONY (Male, 30s): The leading man of our show. Deep voice with some texture. Maybe a hint of a southern accent but not required. Rugged lumberjack vibes, but emotionally intelligent. He's a salt of the earth, creative kind of guy who can fix anything. Divorced dad, ex-rock n' roll musician, now handyman and artist. He's the type to tell it like it is and is not afraid to say how he feels.

BRIAN (Male, early 40s): Shannon's husband. Sweet and supportive husband and dad. An indoor kinda guy who would rather spend an afternoon playing videogames with the kids than playing catch. Stuck in a career he doesn't love. Charming, lovable and a little bit dorky.


- **Joel** (Male, 30s): Claire's friend and former ad agency creative partner. Gay, smart, funny and chaotic. Hard worker. Supportive friend.

- **Various** (Male or Female) 2-3 various "featured extra" one liners from servers, roller coaster ride attendants, grocery store clerks, etc.

SCRIPT SAMPLES FOR AUDITIONS:

The roles of SHANNON and CLAIRE have already been cast.

TONY (Male, 30s): The leading man of our show. Deep voice with some texture. Maybe a hint of a southern accent but not required. Rugged lumberjack vibes, but emotionally intelligent. He's a salt of the earth, creative kind of guy who can fix anything. Divorced dad, ex-rock n' roll musician, now handyman and artist. He's the type to tell it like it is and is not afraid to say how he feels.

Scene description: Flirty scene where Tony & Claire bump into each other at the paint store.



TONY

Whatever, you're obsessed with me. I got your Instagram follow request by the way.

CLAIRE

Ha. Oh! Actually, I shouldn't be admitting this...but...I noticed your old beard oil influencer posts!

<mark>TONY</mark>

Oh did you now? Because you would have had to do a deep dive to see those. That was *several* years ago.

CLAIRE

Ok Mr. *Man Bun*. Mr, "anti-social-media". I see you.

TONY

(defensive) The man bun was because of pandemic hair, okay? And I was helping my buddy launch his beard oil side-hustle so I did a little content creation for him at the time. And I like to smell nice!

CLAIRE

So that's why you always smell like a christmas tree farm. I thought it was just your inherent lumberjack essence.

TONY

(flirty) So you like my smell.

CLAIRE Fresh pine is kind of a universally good smell, right?

TONY So. What are you doing for lunch?

BRIAN (Male, early 40s): Shannon's husband. Sweet and supportive husband and dad. An indoor kinda guy who would rather spend an afternoon playing videogames with the kids than playing catch. Stuck in a career he doesn't love. Charming, lovable and a little bit dorky.

Scene description: Shannon & Brian are plotting to get Claire & Tony together.

BRIAN So what's next on the Claire/Tony agenda?

SHANNON

I think we've established this is going to be a slow burn. It's not an enemies-to-lovers because they're already getting along well.

<mark>BRIAN</mark>

So it's a friends-to-lovers.

SHANNON

That's dangerous territory for Claire. Once she has friend-zoned a guy, there's no coming back.

<mark>BRIAN</mark>

Okay, it's a slow burn, but we need to amp up the burn.

SHANNON

Too bad it isn't Christmas. There's so much we could do with that.

<mark>BRIAN</mark>

Okay what about magical moments? What can we do with Spring holidays? The flowers are blooming. I've always wanted to run through a field of wildflowers toward the woman I love and then lift you into my arms while spinning around, cinematically.

Joel (Male, 30s): Claire's friend and ad agency creative partner. Gay, snarky, smart, funny and chaotic. Hard worker. Supportive friend.

Scene description: Joel calls Claire to partner with him on a big project for work featuring his celebrity crush.

JOEL:
Claire! I need you!
CLAIRE: Okaayyy, so what's up?
JOEL:
This is all under NDA. So legally I'm not
telling you this. But! We're pitching a
campaign for a candy bar. Rhymes with
<mark>Schlickers and -</mark>
CLAIRE:
Schlickers?! That's the word you chose to

rhyme with Snickers?

JOEL: Moving on! We're pitching it with Jake Fisher. CLAIRE: Wait. THE Jake Fisher? JOEL: Yes. I die. I'm dead. You're talking to a ghost. CLAIRE: Jake Fisher, like the Sexiest Man Alive Jake Fisher? Six-foot-four, eight-pack abs, gay icon, universal thirst trap Jake Fisher? JOEL: Yeah, my future husband, that's the one.

Jonathan (Male, age 7): son of Shannon & Brian. Quirky kid, a rule follower and takes things literally. Lovably Neurospicy.

Scene description: lines from a day at 6 Flags

JONATHAN: We're not going to get in trouble are we, Tony? I don't want to get kicked off my first roller coaster. JONATHAN: Oooh hamburgers. Claire, can we get hamburgers? JONATHAN: (laughing) Yeah but you missed Tony spraying soda out of his nose.

Samantha (Female, 10): daughter of Shannon & Brian. Funny, sarcastic gamer girl. Loves snacks, games, hanging with family and friends.

Scene description: Samantha and her brother greeting Aunt Claire after getting off the bus after school.

CLAIRE Samantha, Jonathan-over here! JOHNATHAN Aunt Claire, why'd you drive to the bus stop? SAMANTHA We live two houses away.

CLAIRE Because I sprinted back from a meeting like an unpaid intern. Your parents make this look way too easy. JOHNATHAN They let us play video games. <mark>SAMANTHA</mark> (obviously lying) And they let us get on TikTok. CLAIRE You don't even have phones. **SAMANTHA** Yeah... but you believed me for a second, right? JOHNATHAN Hey Tony! TONY Hey, guys. Remember my daughter, Dominique? DOMINIQUE Hey. SAMANTHA Hey!

Dominique (Female, 12): Tony's piano prodigy daughter. Wise beyond her years but obsessed with TikTok, memes, celeb culture. 12 going on 16. Lives with her moms. Mixed (her mom is Black and dad is White).

Scene description: Dominique and her dad, Tony joke around while waiting in line at 6 Flags.


DOMINIQUE: Daaad, I like my kicks clean. That's the style. Not like you and your grunge friends. Seriously, who wears Converse to a theme park? You've got no arch support in those things. TONY: Dommmmm, that's the style. I have to maintain my rockstar image. DOMINIQUE: Oh, right. When was the last time you played a show again? TONY: Ummm, burn. Ouch. You cut me to my core!

DOMINIQUE:

Don't you miss it though? I could never just stop playing piano. TONY: Waking up hungover at 2 in the afternoon and sleeping on a tour bus with a bunch of smelly dudes? Nah. DOMINIQUE: No, I mean the freedom of expression, playing your heart out, being in the flow, seeing the crowd out there just vibing with the music that YOU are making.

Mom (Female, 70s): Shannon & Claire's mom. Southern Boomer vibes. A bit overbearing, judgmental and places great value on etiquette and tradition. But her heart is in the right place and she loves her daughters.

Scene description: Shannon and Claire argue with their parents about their non-traditional career choices at a family dinner.



You don't have a husband like Brian to support you.

Dad (Male, 70s): Shannon & Claire's Dad. Southern Boomer. Enjoying his retirement after a successful career. Gets a bit overwhelmed by all the strong-willed women in his family.

Scene description: Shannon and Claire argue with their parents about their non-traditional career choices at a family dinner.

DAD But can't you work for a company and get benefits and retirement? DAD We just want you girls to make smart decisions. DAD You don't have student loan debt. I paid for your education.

Jake Fisher (Male, late 20s): Smooth, sexy celebrity heartthrob and LGBTQ icon.

Scene Description: Jake meets Joel and Claire at a Tiki Bar.

JOEL You're Jake effing Fisher.

JAKE FISHER Hi, I'm Jake Effing Fisher.

JOEL Hi. You are even better looking in person. We've met before actually. On zoom.

CLAIRE Yeah, remember that Snickers project? We were the ad agency people.

JAKE FISHER (doesn't actually remember) Oh, yeah???…Yeah, I remember that.

CLAIRE And also you know my sister. She's Shannon Hooper.

<mark>JAKE FISHER</mark>

<mark>Shannon who?</mark>

CLAIRE (quoting his line from earlier) You smell like danger and strawberries? Midnight Darkness?

JAKE FISHER Oh, the audiobook narrator! That Shannon Hooper! She's a gem. Love her.

Various - 2-3 various "featured extra" one liners from servers, roller coaster ride attendants, grocery store clerks, etc. Client is **female**, other roles could be **male or female**.

Direction: read any or all of these lines.

CLIENT

I've got to hand it to you, Claire and Joel. These campaign ideas are unexpected and hard hitting. I wasn't sure you could pull this off, but I think if we launch with the third ad campaign we're going to make headlines!

RIDE OPERATOR: (over bullhorn) Push down on your restraints and fasten your seatbelts.

GAME ATTENDANT

The player with the most points moves across the board.

(announcer-y) Step right up, step right up!

SERVER

So that's a caesar salad with steak frites and a mushroom and swiss burger? I'll put that order right in for you.
