IMPROV WORKSHOP (8-13 & 14+) | \$125

Learn techniques how to be spontaneous and flexible in performance through a series of creative and entertaining activities. 45 minutes. Eight weeks.

DRAMATIC ACTING GROUP (13+) | \$125

Study classical and contemporary literature. Learn characterization and performance techniques. 13+ due to content. 45 minutes. Eight Weeks.

SHAKESPEARE WORKSHOP (11+) | \$175

A comprehensive look at Shakespeare's works by the area's greatest authority, Carolyn Silverberg. 60 minutes. 10 weeks.

CLASSES & WORKSHOPS

BASIC DANCE (4-6Y0) |

Offered through Shirley Van's Dance Studio. See their schedule on the web at Shirleyvans.com.

MT DANCE (6-10, 11+) | \$125

For beginning/intermediate dancers. Learn basic stage movement, posture and a mix of terminology used by directors. 45 minutes. 8 Weeks.

INTRODUCTION TO DANCE U16 | \$125

A Group contemporary dance class. Specific to show choir and cheer- taught by a high school Junior/Senior for kids 10-16. 45 minutes. 8 weeks. Always on Saturday mornings.

CLASSES & WORKSHOPS

ADULT MT TAP DANCE (16+) | \$125

An adult tap class paced for beginners but challenging enough for intermediate tap dancers. Specific to stage performance for Music Theatre. 45 minutes. 8 Weeks.

Studio 12 Intensives

CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

MUSICALITY | \$450

12 weeks of intensive instruction—three weeks each in Keyboard, Music Theory, Music History and Composition. (Students can test out of subjects and apply the freed-up weeks to individual instruction and mentoring). The student will present a capstone project of either an original composition or a lecture on any composition or composer. Project to be presented and juried by area academics and industry professionals. This program is year-long, to fit student schedules. Capstone in spring. Each student will receive a certificate of completion and letter of recommendation from jurors to add to their college application packet.

Studio 12 Intensives

CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

VOCAL PERFORMANCE | \$500

12 weeks of intensive instruction-four each in Contemporary, Music Theater and Classical Repertoire. Multiple performance coaches, one voice teacher. The student will present a six-piece recital, memorized, with at least two classical pieces, the rest being MT and/or contemporary. The recital will be scheduled when the student receives approval from their voice teacher. The recital will be juried and the student will receive a certificate of completion and comments from area academics and performance professionals.

Studio 12 Intensives

CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

MASTER THEATRE | \$450

12 weeks of intensive instruction-four each in Acting, Technical Theater and Direction.

Multiple mentors coaches but one project mentor. As a Capstone, the student will select a non-musical play with 8-10 cast members to direct and perform in spring, 2020. The student must recruit actors to participate in a Student Led Production and all participants will be required to pay a participation fee of \$125. The production will be provided with an \$850 budget. Any proceeds from ticket sales will go to students to offset their costs. The show will be reviewed by area theatre professionals and academics. A certificate of completion will be awarded.

Pedagogy 101 for teaching professionals.

Anatomy & Physiology. 90 minutes. One Week.

VOCAL PEDAGOGY II MASTER CLASS | \$50

Troubleshooting fundamental technique issues and customization for students. 90 minutes.

One Week.

CHOREOGRAPHY FOR EDUCATORS | \$75

Basic choreography technique, spatial awareness and blocking for teachers and new directors. 60 minutes. 2 Weeks.

Similar to General Audition, but specific to Evergreen's Next Production. Various Dates throughout the year. 60 minutes. One Week.

COLLEGE AUDITION MASTER CLASS | \$125

Comprehensive information about college audition preparation, monologues, dance and voice prep. Mock Audition. 90 minutes. 2 Weeks. Includes Materials.

STUDENT LED PRODUCTIONS | \$175

Ever want to direct your own show? Gather 10 people and give it a shot. Each Group will work with a budget of \$1000 to put on a show at the Shirley Van Theatre. Students will receive Weekly mentor assistance from Studio 12 instructors and the community.

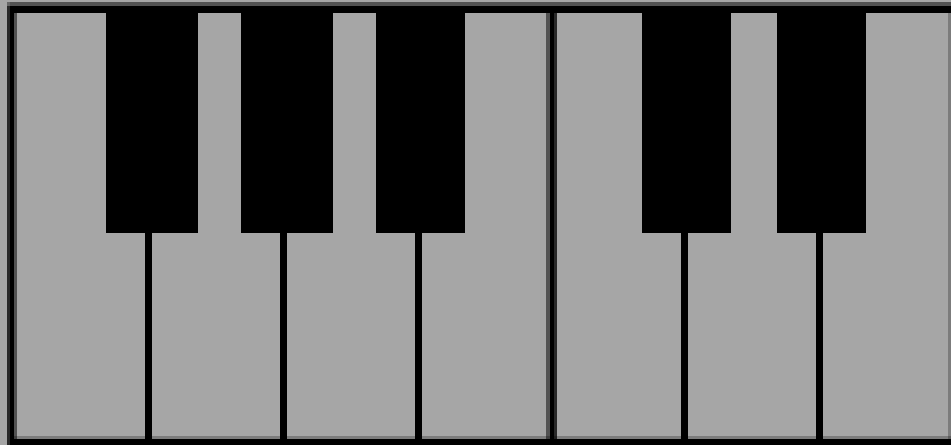
HOW TO ENROLL:
